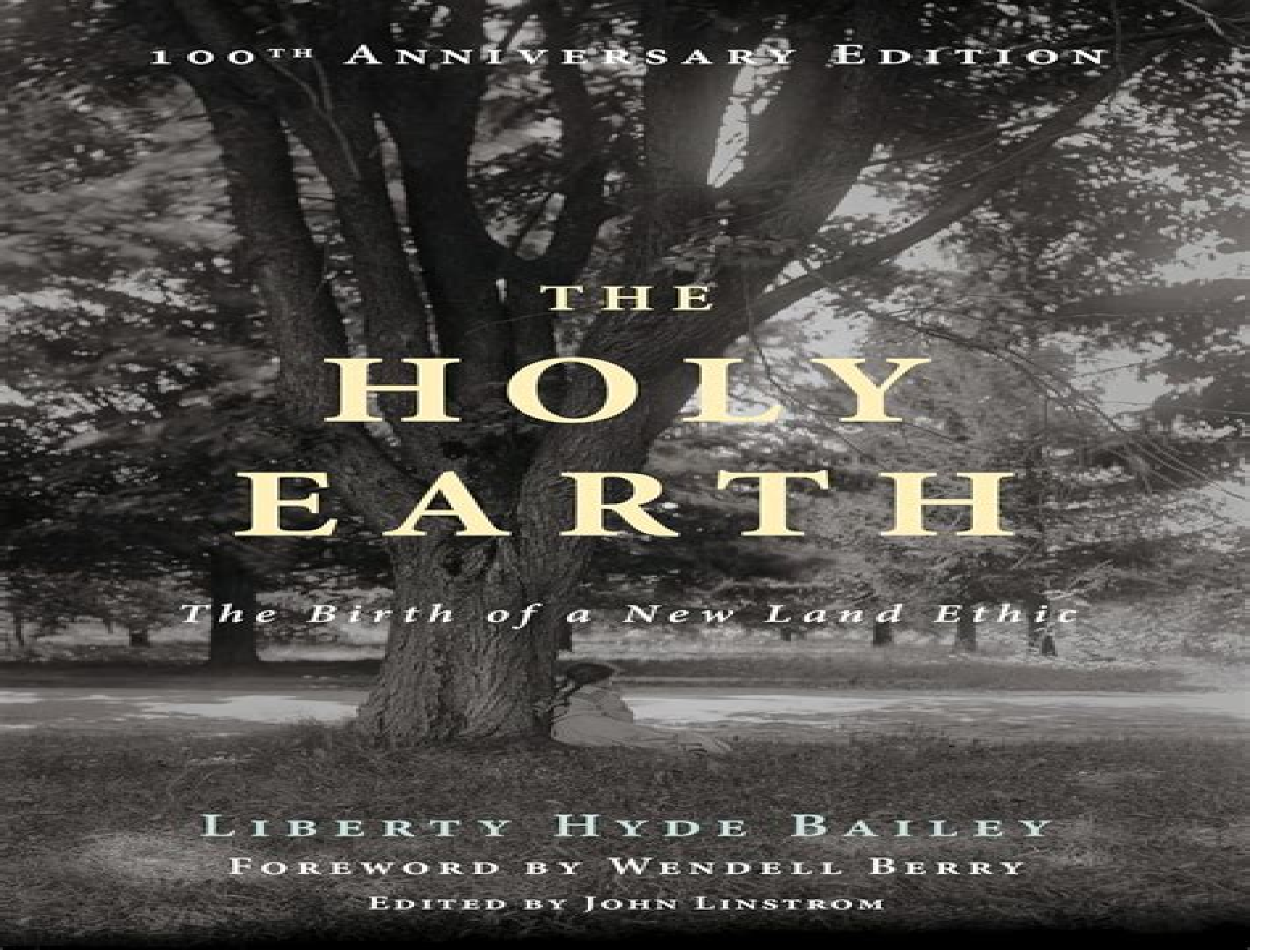

The Holy Earth Liberty Hyde Bailey, 1915 **The Holy Earth** Liberty Hyde Bailey, 2015-12-15 The agrarian tradition runs as an undercurrent through the entire history of literature carrying the age old wisdom that the necessary access of independent farmers to their own land both requires the responsibility of good stewardship and provides the foundation for a thriving civilization At the turn of the last century when farming first began to face the most rapid and extensive series of changes that industrialization would bring the most compelling and humane voice representing the agrarian tradition came from the botanist farmer philosopher and public intellectual Liberty Hyde Bailey In 1915 Bailey s environmental manifesto *The Holy Earth* addressed the industrialization of society by utilizing the full range of human vocabulary to assert that the earth s processes and products because they form the governing conditions of human life should therefore be understood not first as economic but as divine To grasp the extent of human responsibility for the earth Bailey called for a new hold that society must take to develop a morals of land management which would later inspire Aldo Leopold s land ethic and several generations of agrarian voices This message of responsible land stewardship has never been as timely as now

Northcott, 2015-06-18 People are born in one place Traditionally humans move around more than other animals but in modernity the global mobility of persons and the factors of production increasingly disrupts the sense of place that is an intrinsic part of the human experience of being on earth Industrial development and fossil fuelled mobility negatively impact the sense of place and help to foster a culture of placelessness where buildings fields and houses increasingly display a monotonous aesthetic At the same time ecological habitats and diverse communities of

species are degraded Romantic resistance to the industrial evisceration of place and ecological diversity involved the setting aside of scenic or sublime landscapes as wilderness areas or parks However the implication of this project is that human dwelling and ecological sustainability are intrinsically at odds In this collection of essays Michael Northcott argues that the sense of the sacred which emanates from local communities of faith sustained a parochial ecology which over the centuries shaped communities that were more socially just and ecologically sustainable than the kinds of exchange relationships and settlement patterns fostered by a global and place blind economy Hence Christian communities in medieval Europe fostered the distributed use and intergenerational care of common resources such as alpine meadows forests or river catchments But contemporary political economists neglect the role of boundaried places and spatial limits in the welfare of human and ecological communities Northcott argues that place based forms of community dwelling and exchange such as a local food economy more closely resemble evolved commons governance arrangements and facilitate the revival of a sense of neighbourhood and of reconnection between persons and the ecological places in which they dwell Living with Nature Frank Fischer, Maarten A.
