



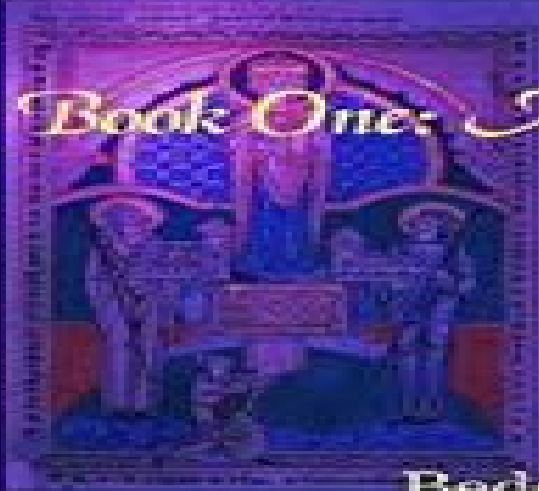

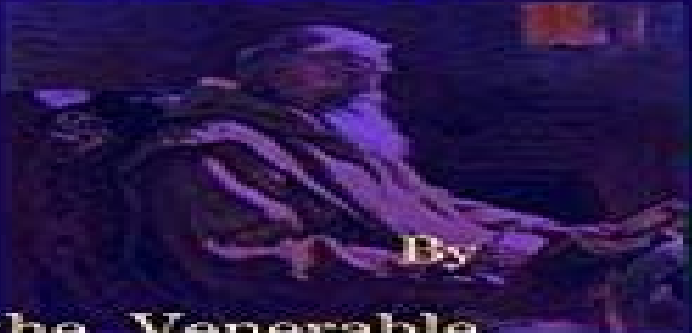

Hildegard of Bingen, Gospel Interpreter Beverly Mayne Kienzle, 2020-11-24 In Hildegard of Bingen Gospel Interpreter Beverly Mayne Kienzle presents and acquaints readers with Hildegard's fifty-eight Homilies on the Gospels a dazzling summa of her theology and the culmination of her visionary insight and scriptural knowledge Part one probes how a twelfth-century woman became the only known female Gospel interpreter of the Middle Ages It includes an examination of Hildegard's epistemology how she received her basic theological education and how she extended her knowledge through divine revelations and intellectual exchange with her monastic network Part two expounds on several of Hildegard's homilies elucidating the theological brilliance that emanates from the creative exegesis she shapes to develop profound interweaving themes Hildegard eschewed the linear repetitive explanations of her predecessors and created an organically coherent body of thought rich with interconnected spiritual symbols Part three deals with the wide-ranging reception of Hildegard's works and her inspiring legacy extending from theology to medicine Her prophetic voice resounds in the morally urgent areas of creation theology and the corruption of church and political leadership Hildegard decries human disregard for the earth and its lust for power Instead she advocates the unifying capacity of nature's viridity that fosters the interconnectedness of all creation

Early Medieval Text and Image Volume 1 Jennifer O'Reilly, 2019-06-17 When she died in 2016 Dr Jennifer O'Reilly left behind a body of published and unpublished work in three areas of medieval studies the iconography of the Gospel Books produced in early medieval Ireland and Anglo-Saxon England the writings of Bede and his older Irish contemporary Adomnán of Iona and the early lives of Thomas Becket In these three areas she explored the connections between historical texts artistic images and biblical exegesis This volume brings together nine studies of the Insular Gospel Books One of them on the iconography of the St Gall Gospels Essay 9 was left completed but unpublished on the author's death It appears here for the first time The remaining studies published between 1987 and 2013 examine certain themes and motifs that inform the Gospel Books their implicit Christology their

harmonisation of the four Gospel accounts the depiction of Christ crucified and the portrayal of St John the Evangelist Two of the Books the Durham Gospels and the Gospels of Mael Brigte receive particular attention CS1079 Heaven's Purge Isabel Moreira,2010-11-17 Heaven's Purge traces purgatory's roots in the texts and debates of late antiquity Illuminating the varied perspectives on post mortem purgation in late antiquity Isabel Moreira challenges the conclusions of recent scholarship through an examination of the texts communities and cultural ideas that informed purgatory's early history **Iconophilia** Francesca Dell'Acqua,2020-05-07 Between the late seventh and the mid ninth centuries a debate about sacred images conventionally addressed as Byzantine iconoclasm engaged monks emperors and popes in the Mediterranean area and on the European continent The importance of this debate cannot be overstated it challenged the relation between image text and belief A series of popes staunchly in favour of sacred images acted consistently during this period in displaying a remarkable iconophilia or love for images Their multifaceted reaction involved not only council resolutions and diplomatic exchanges but also public religious festivals liturgy preaching and visual arts the mass media of the time Embracing these tools the popes especially promoted themes related to the Incarnation of God which justified the production and veneration of sacred images and extolled the role and the figure of the Virgin Mary Despite their profound influence over Byzantine and western cultures of later centuries the political theological and artistic interactions between the East and the West during this period have not yet been investigated in studies combining textual and material evidence By drawing evidence from texts and material culture some of which have yet to be discussed against the background of the iconoclastic controversy and by considering the role of oral exchange Iconophilia assesses the impact of the debate on sacred images and of coeval theological controversies in Rome and central Italy By looking at intersecting textual liturgical and pictorial images which had at their core the Incarnate God and his human mother Mary the book demonstrates that between c 680 880 by unremittingly maintaining the importance of the visual for nurturing beliefs and mediating personal and communal salvation the popes ensured that the status of sacred images would remain unchallenged at least until the Protestant Reformation in the sixteenth century
