Monirul Qader Mirza, 2006-02-03 This book deals with environmental effects on both sides of the border between Bangladesh and India caused by the Ganges water diversion This issue came to my attention in early 1976 when news media in Bangladesh and overseas began publications of articles on the unilateral withdrawal of a huge quantity of water from the Ganges River through the commissioning of the Farakka Barrage in India I first pursued the subject professionally in 1984 while working as a contributor for Bangladesh Today Holiday and New Nation During the next two decades I followed the protracted hydro political negotiations between the riparian countries in the Ganges basin and I traveled extensively to observe the environmental and ecological changes in Bangladesh as well as India that occurred due to the water diversion The Ganges one of the longest rivers of the world originates at the Gangotri glacier in the Himalayas and flows across the plains of North India Eventually the river splits into two main branches and empties into the Bay of Bengal The conflict of diversion and sharing of the Ganges water arose in the middle of the last century when the government of India decided to implement a barrage at Farakka to resolve a navigation problem at the Kolkata Port

Watercourses Nahid Islam, 2010-01-01 Presentation de l'auteur Despite Asia's large share of global water resources and the importance of its water for sustaining one of the largest agrarian populations in the world Asia's trans boundary water resource management regimes are poorly developed There are only two working international regimes in South and South east Asia the Mekong and the Indus regimes The remaining international watercourses in Asia are used by riparian countries in a self interested manner without much consideration for the interests of other states or for the environment These national interests do not often represent the interests and needs of the local people This book is divided into three Parts Part I discusses the different contexts of law making in the industrialized west and in agrarian societies in Asia as well as the changing context of law making following the emergence of the concept of sustainable development Part II discusses the regime of international watercourses Part III of the book presents two case studies in Asia the Mekong and the Ganges The main argument is that in the absence of public participation in decision making and resource management the basin states revert to using the watercourses according to the principles of the classical regime The result so far has been unsustainable development environmental degradation and growing poverty of local user communities

Monirul Qader Mirza, Ajaya Dixit, Ainun Nishat, 2013-03-09 Flood Problem and Management in South Asia focuses on both the hazard and the vulnerability aspects of floods This book addresses floods in South Asia from a multidisciplinary approach The characteristics and nature of the flood problem and its management aspects are examined It is suggested that flood control and management focused on structural solutions using embankments and reservoirs are insufficient Effective solutions must go beyond structural measures and require major restructuring of both legal systems and institutions responsible for management For those people living in the vast flood plains of South Asia to be able to overcome social economic and environmental vulnerabilities an adaptive approach to management of flood risks that identifies specific strategies is needed

Water Conflicts in India K.J. Joy, Suhas Paranjape, Biksham Gujja, Vinod Goud, Shruti Vispute, 2020-11-29 Water conflicts in India have now percolated to every level They are aggravated by the relative paucity of frameworks policies and mechanisms to govern the use of water resources Based on the premise that understanding and documenting different types of water conflict cases in all their complexity would contribute to informed public debate and facilitate their resolution Forum for Policy Dialogue on Water Conflicts in India a collaborative initiative of the WWF project Dialogue on Water Food and Environment documented a number of such case studies One of its kind in India this book brings together an impressive sixty three case studies summarized status of the conflicts the issues involved and their current position and gives us a glimpse

into the million revolts that are brewing around water. While recognizing that each conflict is a microcosm of wider conflicts, the editors have classified these cases into eight broad themes that try to capture the dominant aspect of the conflict. These are: contending water uses, dams and displacement, equity, access, allocations, micro level conflicts, water quality, trans boundary conflicts, privatization, sand excavation and mining. With a mix of academics and activists as contributors, the book makes an important contribution to a new discourse on water in general and water conflicts and conflict resolution in particular.

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
