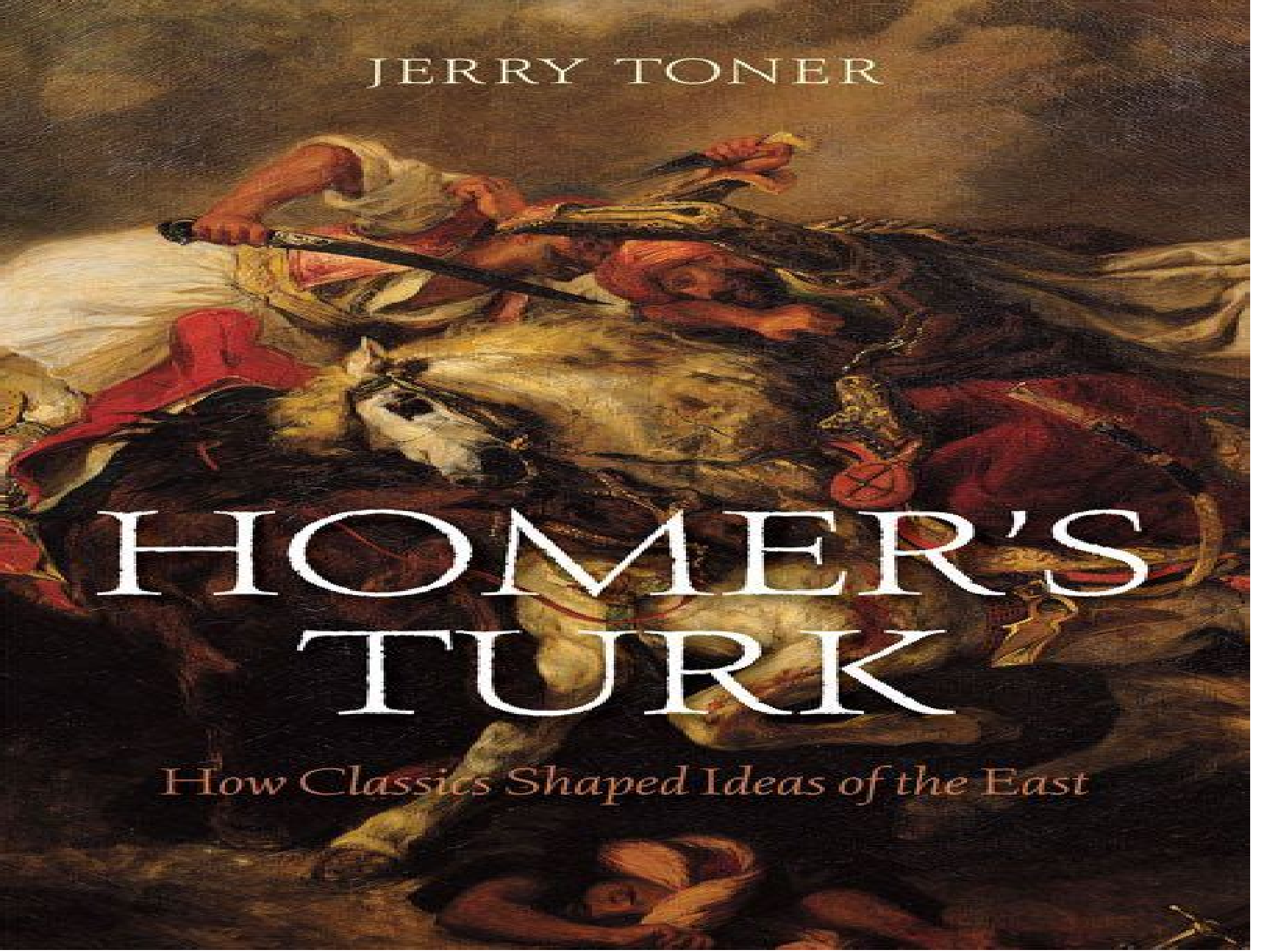

Whitman and Ezra Pound that bear responsibility for the ruin of today's classics in translation to say nothing of poetry in the twentieth century Beyond matters of reflection for classicists Duban provides a far ranging beginner's guide to classical literature with forays into Spenser and Milton and into the colonial impulse of Virgil Spenser and the West at large
