Granny Ingles the children's grandmother in Cookham Dean in the village of Cookham in Berkshire There the children lived in a spacious if dilapidated home The Mount on spacious grounds in idyllic surroundings and were introduced to the riverside and boating by their uncle David Ingles curate at Cookham Dean church This delightful ambiance particularly Quarry Wood and the River Thames is believed by Peter Green his biographer to have inspired the setting for The Wind in the Willows He was an outstanding pupil at St Edward's School in Oxford During his early years at St Edwards a sports regimen had not been established and the boys had freedom to explore the old city with its quaint shops historic buildings and cobblestone streets St Giles Fair the idyllic upper reaches of the River Thames and the nearby countryside Grahame died in Pangbourne Berkshire in 1932 He is buried in Holywell Cemetery Oxford Grahame's cousin Anthony Hope also a successful author wrote his epitaph which reads To the beautiful memory of Kenneth Grahame husband of Elspeth and father of Alastair who passed the river on the 6th of July 1932 leaving childhood and literature through him the more blest for all time
