Holy Week A Novel Of The Warsaw Ghetto Uprising:

Holy Week Jerzy Andrzejewski, 2006-12-01 At the height of the Nazi extermination campaign in the Warsaw Ghetto a young Jewish woman Irena seeks the protection of her former lover a young architect Jan Malecki By taking her in he puts his own life and the safety of his family at risk Over a four day period Tuesday through Friday of Holy Week 1943 as Irena becomes increasingly traumatized by her situation Malecki questions his decision to shelter Irena in the apartment where Malecki his pregnant wife and his younger brother reside Added to his dilemma is the broader context of Poles attitudes toward the Jewish guestion and the plight of the Jews locked in the ghetto during the final moments of its existence Few fictional works dealing with the war have been written so close in time to the events that inspired them No other Polish novel treats the range of Polish attitudes toward the Jews with such unflinching honesty Jerzy Andrzejewski s Holy Week Wielki Tydzien 1945 one of the significant literary works to be published immediately following the Second World War now appears in English for the first time This translation of Andrzejewski s Holy Week began as a group project in an advanced Polish language course at the University of Pittsburgh Class members Daniel M Pennell Anna M Poukish and Matthew J Russin contributed to the translation the instructor Oscar E Swan was responsible for the overall accuracy and stylistic unity of the translation as well as for the biographical and critical notes and essays Handbook of Polish, Czech, and Slovak Holocaust Fiction Elisa-Maria Hiemer, Jiří Holý, Agata Firlej, Hana Nichtburgerová, 2021-06-21 The Handbook of Polish Czech and Slovak Holocaust Fiction aims to increase the visibility and show the versatility of works from East Central European countries It is the first encyclopedic work to bridge the gap between the literary production of countries that are considered to be main sites of the Holocaust and their recognition in international academic and public discourse It contains over 100 entries offering not only facts about the content and motifs but also pointing out the characteristic fictional features of each work and its meaning for academic discourse and wider reception in the country of origin and abroad The publication will appeal to the academic and broader public interested in the representation of the Holocaust anti Semitism and World War II in literature and the arts Besides prose it also considers poetry and theatrical plays from 1943 through 2018 An introduction to the historical events and cultural developments in Poland Czechoslovakia Czech and Slovak Republic and their impact on the artistic output helps to contextualise the motif changes and fictional strategies that authors have been applying for decades The publication is the result of long term scholarly cooperation of specialists from four countries and several dozen academic centres Polish Film and the Holocaust Marek Haltof, 2012 During World War II Poland lost more than six million people including about three million Polish Jews who perished in the ghettos and extermination camps built by Nazi Germany in occupied Polish territories This book is the first to address the representation of the Holocaust in Polish film and does so through a detailed treatment of several films which the author frames in relation to the political ideological and cultural contexts of the times in which they were created Following the chronological development of Polish Holocaust

films the book begins with two early classics Wanda Jakubowska's The Last Stage 1948 and Aleksander Ford's Border Street 1949 and next explores the Polish School period represented by Andrzej Wajda's A Generation 1955 and Andrzej Munk's The Passenger 1963 Between 1965 and 1980 there was an organized silence regarding sensitive Polish Jewish relations resulting in only a few relevant films until the return of democracy in 1989 when an increasing number were made among them Krzysztof Kie lowski s Decalogue 8 1988 Andrzej Wajda s Korczak 1990 Jan Jakub Kolski s Keep Away from the Window 2000 and Roman Pola ski s The Pianist 2002 An important contribution to film studies this book has wider relevance in addressing the issue of Poland's national memory Marta Eliza Orzeszkowa, 2018-08-07 Eliza Orzeszkowa was a trailblazing Polish novelist who alongside Leo Tolstoy and Henryk Sienkiewicz was a finalist for the 1905 Nobel Prize in Literature Of her many works of social realism Marta 1873 is among the best known but until now it has not been available in English Easily a peer of The Awakening and A Doll s House the novel was well ahead of the English literature of its time in attacking the ways the labor market failed women Suddenly widowed the previously middle class Marta wicka is left penniless and launched into a grim battle for her survival and that of her small daughter As she applies for job after job in Warsaw portrayed here as an every city an unforgiving commercial landscape that could be any European metropolis of the time she is told time after time that only men will be hired that men need jobs because they are fathers and heads of families Marta burns with Orzeszkowa s feminist conviction that sexism was not just an annoyance but a threat to the survival of women and children It anticipated the need for social safety nets whose existence we take for granted today and could easily read as an indictment of current efforts to dismantle those very programs Tightly plotted and exquisitely translated by Anna G sienica Byrcyn and Stephanie Kraft Marta resonates beyond its Polish setting to find its place in women's studies labor history and among other works of nineteenth century literature and literature of social change Forgetting Polish Violence Against the Jews Tomasz Żukowski, 2024-11-29 During the Holocaust Polish bystanders were witnesses not only to Nazi crimes but also to their own collective violence toward Jewish neighbors This book shows how these memories continue to be distorted and silenced in the Polish culture Considering the ways in which Polish culture displays symptoms of a suppressed and violent memory while obstinately refusing to see the meaning of such symptoms the author shows how the narrative of the Holocaust in threatening the self image of the community causes a continuous anxiety and thus compulsive and neurotic reactions Through analyses of a wide range of literary journalistic commemorative and cinematic texts Forgetting Polish Violence Against the Jews sheds light on a set of narrative and discursive models connected with social practices which serve to discipline individuals especially Polish Jews while generating pressure to defend both habits of silence and also an idealized selfimage of the Polish Christian majority This book will appeal to scholars with interests in memory studies cultural studies Holocaust studies and psychoanalytic studies The Holocaust as Active Memory Marie Louise Seeberg, Irene Levin, Claudia Lenz, 2016-03-09 The ways in which memories of the Holocaust have been communicated represented and used have

Rome's Most Faithful Daughter Neal Pease, 2009-10-15 When an independent Poland reappeared on the map of Europe after World War I it was widely regarded as the most Catholic country on the continent as Rome s Most Faithful Daughter All the same the relations of the Second Polish Republic with the Church both its representatives inside the country and the Holy See itself proved far more difficult than expected Based on original research in the libraries and depositories of four countries including recently opened collections in the Vatican Secret Archives Rome s Most Faithful Daughter The Catholic Church and Independent Poland 1914 1939 presents the first scholarly history of the close but complex political relationship of Poland with the Catholic Church during the interwar period Neal Pease addresses for example the centrality
