1.2.4 Regency style (1800-1840)

The end of the 18th century following the French Revolution, was a period of significant social, industrial and aesthetic change in Ireland, Britain and across much of Europe. In architecture, this was manifested in the adoption of a much wider range of architectural styles – 'a taste of style' in effect, with a new trend towards the picturesque qualities of Gothic architecture as well as a continuing taste for classical architecture.

In the field of tradition, practices of form and pattern continued to be used, but to an

increasingly chosen manner with increasing awareness passed back. Classical styles, influenced by ancient Greek architecture, became increasingly popular, giving rise to what is known as the Greek Revival. This was characterised by the use of tall column porticoes, weighty Greek Ionic columns and the columned Greek base classical orders. In the case of most houses, the use of classical columns and orders tended to be reserved for the entrance. Only the grandest mansions and public buildings were provided with great stone porticos modelled on ancient Greek temples such as the Parthenon.

Indeed, the majority of Regency houses lack formal classical features and display an elegance and sense of informality characteristic of the age of Jane Austen. With a new interest in gardening and landscape, windows were often made larger. Most windows were particularly popular together with bays and bowers, while French doors leading on to a lawn or veranda were the height of fashion. The availability of large British glass made it possible to have much which others had long, overhanging eaves, and walls were given smooth, 'marble' finishes.

Side by side with a taste for classical was one for Gothic architecture. This arose in part from the age of the romantics – romantically idealistic romantics – as in theories of travelling through and within. At the same time, the Napoleonic wars raging across Europe prevented travel to the continent and the varied incidents of architecture, as well as their pattern, as look to the old stories, romances and tales of Britain and Ireland for inspiration for learning and exploration. Gothic architecture was now seen as a national architecture and it quickly became fashionable to build domestic mansions in the Gothic or castle style and later, the Victor style. More modest houses could also be made Gothic by the use of pointed arch windows and doors, intricate window tracery, bays or bays mouldings over windows and battlemented porches and porches.

By the 1830s, there was a taste for building houses in the 'little English cottage' style, with gabled roofs, tall chimneys, curved hipped roofs, porches and windows topped with eaves and windows with awnings and small leaded panes of glass. Classical forms also continued to be fashionable. A new 'Gothic' style emerged which used classical motifs in a less-headed manner with pediments over windows, battlemented porches and bays below the eaves of roofs.

1.2.5 Victorian style (1840-1900)

Queen Victoria's accession to the throne in 1837 coincided with a remarkable period of industrial

revolution. The development of rolling materials allowed people to spend considerably and relatively cheaply, making more various possible for the first time. The railways also made it possible to transport building materials far and wide. Together with the industrialised production of iron, brick, concrete, glass and steel, builders and architects were provided with an increasingly varied choice of materials that are such a characteristic of Victorian buildings.

There were architects and their patron the opportunity to experience the varied French and Italian forms of Gothic architecture as well as the continent's great classical buildings. Nevertheless, native British styles continued to be widely popular in part through the publications of Augustus Welby Pugin. Pugin was one of the first to view the Gothic style in a positive way, insisting that any ornament had to serve a function and be a product of a building's structure, not merely an ornate applied decoration.

However, many houses were continued to be designed in a style that changed little from the Regency period with simple wooden frames and vertical proportions to door and window tops. Gothic forms, where used, tended to be somewhat restrained and Gothic details were often confined to pointed arch doorways and a few roof eaves, windows.

It was during this period that stone-built, suburban housing emerged for the first time, with some of developers led by local and semi-developed

As large panes of glass became available at affordable prices, small-paned, 'Georgian style' windows gave way to rather glazed with single panes of glass. The long tradition of ornamental leaded lighted steadily waning to the taste for plain, glazed ledlights.

1.2.6 Edwardian style (1890-1910)

The distinctive Edwardian style came into existence from about 1890, several years before King Edward VII actually came to the throne. It
