Women and Disability Mary Jo Deegan, 2018-04-27 The special needs of women with disabilities have been disregarded in a wide variety of vital areas Issues pertain to women as wives and mothers Studies of the effects on female sexuality of such conditions as renal disease and diabetes are lacking though the sexual functioning of men with these diseases has been researched On the economic front the Federal State Vocational Rehabilitation system and the regulations concerning disability benefits under Social Security provide less adequately for women than for men Hopefully this volume will raise the consciousness of its readers to the special status of women with disabilities as a minority group experiences multiple sources of discriminations

Hanson,2003-03-14 Mary McLeod Bethune was a significant figure in American political history She devoted her life to advancing equal social economic and political rights for blacks She distinguished herself by creating lasting institutions that trained black women for visible and expanding public leadership roles Few have been as effective in the development of women s leadership for group advancement Despite her accomplishments the means techniques and actions Bethune employed in fighting for equality have been widely misinterpreted Mary McLeod Bethune and Black Women s Political Activism seeks to remedy the misconceptions surrounding this important political figure Joyce A Hanson shows that the choices Bethune made often appear contradictory unless one understands that she was a transitional figure with one foot in the nineteenth century and the other in the twentieth Bethune who lived from 1875 to 1955 struggled to reconcile her nineteenth century notions of women s moral superiority with the changing political realities of the twentieth century She used two conceptually distinct levels of activism one nonconfrontational and designed to slowly undermine systemic racism the other openly confrontational and designed to challenge the most overt discrimination in her efforts to achieve equality Hanson uses a wide range of never or little used primary sources and adds a significant dimension to the historical discussion of black women s organizations by such scholars as Elsa Barkley Brown Sharon Harley and Rosalyn Terborg Penn The book extends the current debate about black women s political activism in recent work by Stephanie Shaw Evelyn Brooks Higginbotham and Glenda Elizabeth Gilmore Examining the historical evolution of African American women s activism in the critical period between 1920 and 1950 a time previously characterized as doldrums for both feminist and civil rights activity Mary McLeod Bethune and Black Women s Political Activism is important for understanding the centrality of black women to the political fight for social economic and racial justice **Broadening the Contours in the Study of Black Politics** Michael Mitchell,2017-07-05 Broadening the Contours in the Study of Black Politics volume 17 of the National Political Science Review NPSR is divided thematically into two books available separately or as a set The first concentrates on the institutional aspects of Black politics The second book addresses various dimensions of social capital that constitute the fundamental building blocks of Black politics Each contains peer reviewed articles a symposium section and book reviews as well as other featured sections Together these books build on the previous NPSR volume Black Women in Politics The symposium in Volume 17 1 examines the struggle of Black women both in the political science discipline and in getting their work published In the symposium section of Volume 17 2 members of the National Conference of Black Political Scientists carry on a revealing conversation about the dilemmas of professional life for Black women in political science The set also

To Advance the Race Linda M. Perkins,2024-04-09 From the United States earliest days African Americans considered education essential for their freedom and progress Linda M Perkins s study ranges across educational and geographical settings to tell the stories of Black women and girls as students professors and administrators Beginning with early efforts and the establishment of abolitionist colleges Perkins follows the history of Black women s post Civil War experiences at elite white schools and public universities in northern and midwestern states Their presence in Black institutions like Howard University marked another advancement as did Black women becoming professors and administrators But such progress intersected with race and education in the postwar era As gender questions sparked conflict between educated Black women and Black men it forced the former to contend with traditional notions of women s roles even as the 1960s opened educational opportunities for all African Americans A first of its kind history To Advance the Race is an enlightening look at African American women and their multi generational commitment to the ideal of education as a collective achievement

Written Out Joel Cabrita, 2023-01-17 Systemic racism and sexism caused one of South Africa's most important writers to disappear from public consciousness. Is it possible to justly restore her historical presence? Regina Gelana Twala, a Black South African woman who died in 1968 in Swaziland (now Eswatini), was an extraordinarily prolific writer of books, columns, articles, and letters. Yet today, Twala's name is largely unknown. Her literary achievements are forgotten. Her books are unpublished. Her letters languish in the dusty study of a deceased South African academic. Her articles are buried in discontinued publications. Joel Cabrita argues that Twala's posthumous obscurity has not developed accidentally, as she exposes the ways prejudices around race and gender blocked Black African women like Twala from establishing themselves as successful writers. Drawing upon Twala's family papers, interviews, newspapers, and archival records from Pretoria, Uppsala, and Los Angeles, Cabrita argues that an entire cast of characters—censorious editors, territorial White academics, apartheid officials, and male African politicians whose politics were at odds with her own—conspired to erase

Twala's legacy Through her unique documentary output Twala marked herself as a radical voice on issues of gender race and class The literary gatekeepers of the racist and sexist society of twentieth century southern Africa clamped down by literally writing her out of the region's history Written Out also scrutinizes the troubled racial politics of African history as a discipline that has been historically dominated by White academics a situation that many people within the field are now examining critically Inspired by this recent movement Cabrita interrogates what it means for her a White historian based in the Northern Hemisphere to tell the story of a Black African woman Far from a laudable recovery of an important lost figure Cabrita acknowledges that her biography inevitably reproduces old dynamics of White scholarly privilege and dominance Cabrita's narration of Twala's career resurrects it but also reminds us that Twala tragically is still not the author of her own life story
