

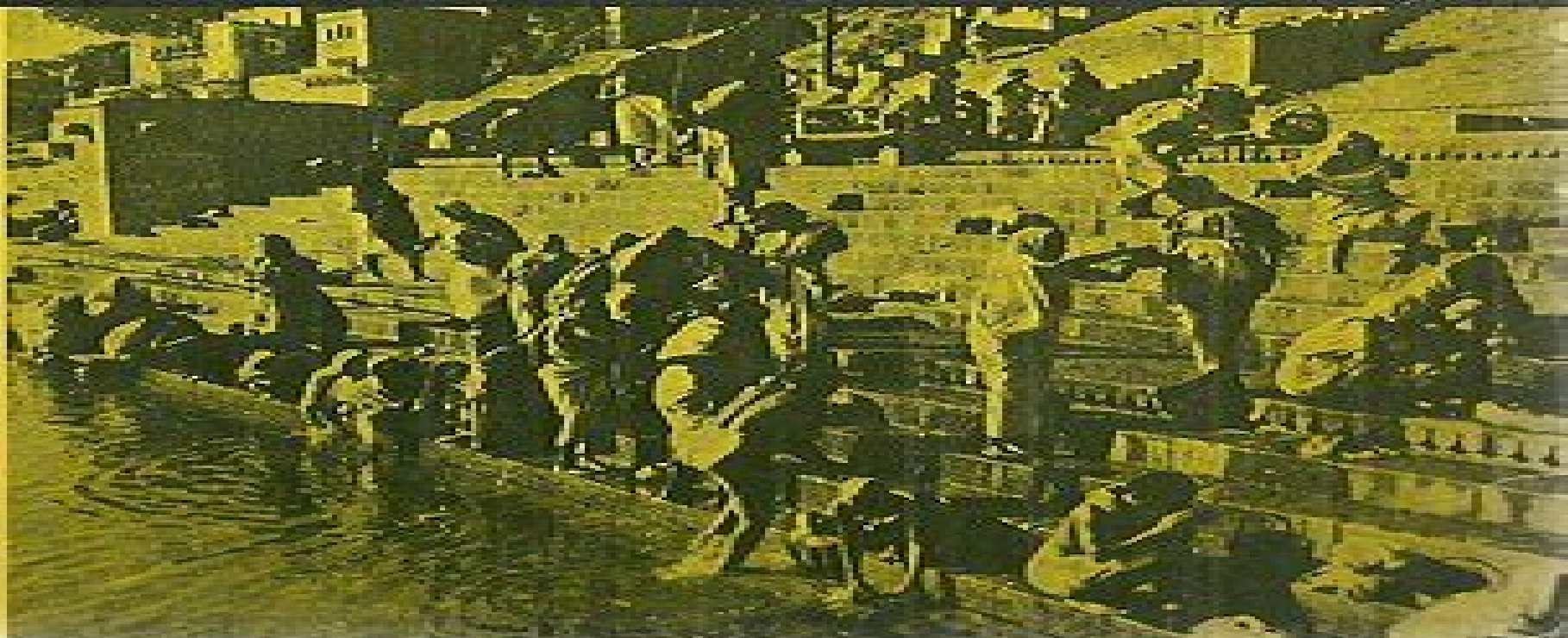

Smith, 1987 In this broad ranging inquiry into ritual and its relation to place Jonathan Z Smith prepares the way for a new approach to the comparative study of religion Smith stresses the importance of place in particular constructed ritual environments to a proper understanding of the ways in which empty actions become rituals He structures his argument around the territories of the Tjilpa aborigines in Australia and two sites in Jerusalem the temple envisioned by Ezekiel and the Church of the Holy Sepulchre The first of these locales the focus of one of the more important contemporary theories of religious ritual allows Smith to raise questions concerning the enterprise of comparison His close examination of Eliade's influential interpretation of the Tjilpa tradition leads to a powerful critique of the approach to religion myth and ritual that begins with cosmology and the category of The Sacred In substance and in method *To Take Place* represents a significant advance toward a theory of ritual It is of great value not only to historians of religion and students of ritual but to all whether social scientists or humanists who are concerned with the nature of place This book is extraordinarily stimulating in prompting one to think about the ways in which space or place is perceived marked and utilized religiously A provocative example of the application of humanistic geography to our understanding of what takes place in religion Dale Goldsmith Interpretation *Homo Hierarchicus* Dumont, 1981 *The Art of Contextual Theology* Victor I. prescriptions of this community as the main factors that intersect with gendered identity construction and succeed in keeping women within its patriarchal confines While women do engage in negotiating patriarchy through what can be termed simulative tactical and agensic bargains this remains a politics of survival as it does not challenge the established gender order In this context making a shift from politics of survival to a politics of subversion is imperative for challenging persisting patriarchies

Categories of Self André Celtel, 2004-12-01 Drawing on anthropological socio psychological religious and philosophical material this book engages in a discussion of what it means to be an individual in relation to notions of selfhood personality and social role This theme is explored with reference to the investigations of Louis Dumont into Hindu and other Indian ideologies and with regard to the dominant threads of Western individualism Clarifying and at times building upon his analyses the author follows Dumont in a consideration of Indian ideology Hindu non individualism the individual social personhood French ideology sociopolitical individualism German ideology subjective individualism and Western ideology the Christian beginnings of individualism political and economic individualism the philosophical categorisation of self While most commentators have tended to focus primarily on one aspect of Dumont's work either his views on Indian hierarchy or writings on modern individualism the author reveals considerable continuity throughout Dumont's entire oeuvre based around the notion of categories and the concept of the individual Dumont's intellectual background is explored with reference to the Durkheimian tradition with Marcel Mauss being highlighted as the principal architect in his thinking In particular Dumont's interest in the category of the individual is shown to be an extension of Mauss's concern with the category of the person The distinctiveness of Dumont's structuralist approach is thrown into full relief through comparison with that of others acknowledging an intellectual debt to Mauss namely Claude Lévi Strauss and Fernand Braudel The book covers an assessment of general approaches to the study of individualism with the relevant perspectives of other thinkers discussed and related to Dumont's approach as appropriate
