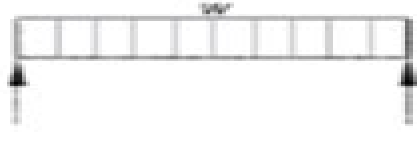

in the units special features related to the detailing of the reinforcement and so forth Chapter eleven gives guidelines for the fire design of precast concrete structures The handbook concludes with a list of references to good literature on precast concrete construction
