Addresses diversity and inclusion in psychiatry training, first by examining the LCME accreditation standard introduced in 2009, next by considering the impact of recruiting international medical graduates, and finally by discussing a holistic review, a flexible approach to increasing diversity, and promoting equity in the GME recruitment process.
