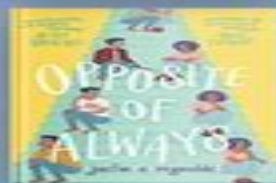

predecessors through expanding gender roles She also demonstrates how different types of abdication work to transform readers expectations of royals and how they reach a happy ending different from traditional folktales and Disney Finally employing Rudine Sims Bishop s ideas about mirrors windows and sliding glass doors she explores how queer royals and royals of color offer new mirrors for children and young adults Each chapter presents a typology of royal books related to the topic and explains how they work to transform the folktale tradition Doughty concludes with a discussion of the transformational gaps remaining in royal children s and YA literature
