

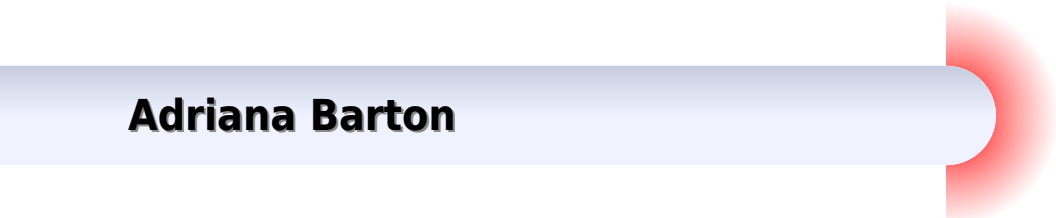

How Musical is Man? John Blacking, 1973 This important study in ethnomusicology is an attempt by the author a musician who has become a social anthropologist to compare his experiences of music making in different cultures He is here presenting new information resulting from his research into African music especially among the Venda Venda music he discovered is in its way no less complex in structure than European music Literacy and the invention of nation may generate extended musical structures but they express differences of degree and not the difference in kind that is implied by the distinction between art and folk music Many if not all of music's essential processes may be found in the constitution of the human body and in patterns of interaction of human bodies in society Thus all music is structurally as well as functionally folk music in the sense that music cannot be transmitted or have meaning without associations between people If John Blacking's guess about the biological and social origins of music is correct or even only partly correct it would generate new ideas about the nature of musicality the role of music in education and its general role in societies which like the Venda in the context of their traditional economy will have more leisure time as automation increases

The Essence Of Chaos Edward N. Lorenz, 1995 Chaos surrounds us Seemingly random events the flapping of a flag a storm driven wave striking the shore a pinball's path often appear to have no order no rational pattern Explicating the theory of chaos and the consequences of its principal findings that actual precise rules may govern such apparently random behavior has been a major part of the work of Edward N Lorenz In *The Essence of Chaos* Lorenz presents to the general reader the features of this new science with its far reaching implications for much of modern life from weather prediction to philosophy and he describes its considerable impact on emerging scientific fields Unlike the phenomena dealt with in relativity theory and quantum mechanics systems that are now described as chaotic can be observed without telescopes or microscopes They range from the simplest

happenings such as the falling of a leaf to the most complex processes like the fluctuations of climate Each process that qualifies however has certain quantifiable characteristics how it unfolds depends very sensitively upon its present state so that even though it is not random it seems to be Lorenz uses examples from everyday life and simple calculations to show how the essential nature of chaotic systems can be understood In order to expedite this task he has constructed a mathematical model of a board sliding down a ski slope as his primary illustrative example With this model as his base he explains various chaotic phenomena including some associated concepts such as strange attractors and bifurcations As a meteorologist Lorenz initially became interested in the field of chaos because of its implications for weather forecasting In a chapter ranging through the history of weather prediction and meteorology to a brief picture of our current understanding of climate he introduces many of the researchers who conceived the experiments and theories and he describes his own initial encounter with chaos A further discussion invites readers to make their own chaos Still others debate the nature of randomness and its relationship to chaotic systems and describe three related fields of scientific thought nonlinearity complexity and fractality Appendixes present the first publication of Lorenz's seminal paper Does the Flap of a Butterfly's Wing in Brazil Set Off a Tornado in Texas the mathematical equations from which the copious illustrations were derived and a glossary

The Publishers' Trade List Annual, 1990 **Language and Human Behavior** Derek Bickerton, 2016-06-01 What this book proposes to do writes Derek Bickerton is to stand the conventional wisdom of the behavioral sciences on its head instead of the human species growing clever enough to invent language it will view that species as blundering into language and as a direct result of that becoming clever According to Bickerton the behavioral sciences have failed to give an adequate account of human nature at least partly because of the conjunction and mutual reinforcement of two widespread beliefs that language is simply a means of communication and that human intelligence is the result of the rapid growth and unusual size of human brains Bickerton argues that each of the properties distinguishing human intelligence and consciousness from that of other animals can be shown to derive straightforwardly from properties of language In essence language arose as a representational system not a means of communication or a skill and not a product

of culture but an evolutionary adaptation The author stresses the necessity of viewing intelligence in evolutionary terms seeing it not as problem solving but as a way of maintaining homeostasis the preservation of those conditions most favorable to an organism the optimal achievable conditions for survival and well being Nonhumans practice what he calls on line thinking to maintain homeostasis but only humans can employ off line thinking only humans can assemble fragments of information to form a pattern that they can later act upon without having to wait on that great but unpunctual teacher experience The term protolanguage is used to describe the stringing together of symbols that prehuman hominids employed It did not allow them to turn today s imagination into tomorrow s fact But it is just this power to transform imagination into fact that distinguishes human behavior from that of our ancestral species and indeed from that of all other species It is exactly what enables us to change our behavior or invent vast ranges of new behavior practically overnight with no concomitant genetic changes Language and Human Behavior should be of interest to anyone in the behavioral and evolutionary sciences and to all those concerned with the role of language in human behavior **Recording for the Blind & Dyslexic, ...
