- John Locke believed the job of government was to protect the rights of people or be overthrown, and his ideas greatly influenced the American colonists
- Major Enlightenment thinkers:
 - Locke = Natural Rights
 - Montesquieu = Separation of Powers
 - Voltoire = Freedom of Speech
- Enlightenment ideas led to the American Revolutionary Wor, the Declaration of Independence, U.S. Constitution, Bill of Rights, and the French Revolution.

INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION (CONTINUED):

- Urbanization led to several negative effects:
 - Pollution
 - Dangerous working conditions
 - Long hours and low wages
 - Owlid lioteor
 - Slums and poor housing conditions
 - Cromped living spaces and romount diseases
- Labor unions formed to combot terrible working conditions in foctories and sought better pay, shorter hours, and improved conditions.
- Henry Ford tounder of the Ford Motor Company - used the assembly line to produce his cers fost and cheek this revolutionized manufacturing and gave rise to specialized labor.

INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION (1960 - 1910):

- The Industrial Revolution took place in the late 1700's in Europe and in the early 1800's in America, and it was a time of technological innovation.
- Improved agricultural technology, like steam-powered tractors and large-scale food processing factories led to increased food yields.
- Railroad linked cites, brought materials to factories more efficiently, increased trade between cities and countries, and allowed people to move more freely.
- Many people moved from rural areas to cities to find work in newly built factories, a movement known as urbanization.
