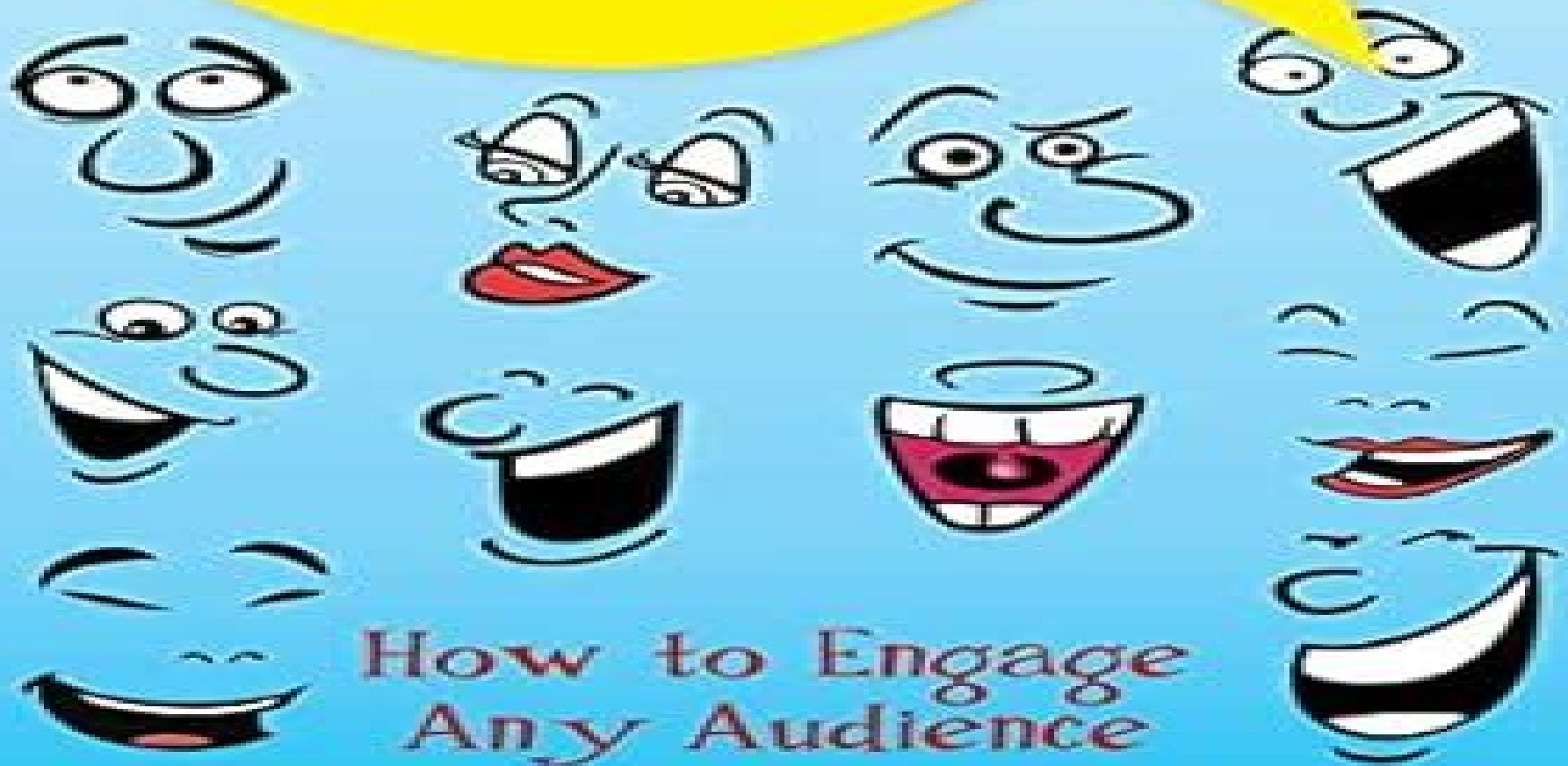

He became a Broadway directing sensation, then moved on to Hollywood where his first two films, *Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf?* (1966) and *The Graduate* (1967) earned a total of 20 Academy Award nominations. Nichols won the 1968 Oscar for Best Director and later joined the rarefied EGOT (Emmy, Grammy, Oscar, Tony) club.
