Creating Consent in Ba'athist Syria Esther Meininghaus, 2016-03-31 The challenge of maintaining dictatorial regimes through control co option and coercion while upholding a facade of legitimacy is something that has concerned leaders throughout the Middle East and beyond Nowhere is this more evident than in the Syria ruled by the Asads both Hafiz and his son Bashar Drawing on the example of the General Union of Syrian Women founded in 1967 Esther Meininghaus offers new insights into how the Syrian Ba'athist regimes attempted to move beyond mere satisfaction with the compliance of the citizenry and to consolidate their rule amongst the local population Meininghaus argues that this was partially achieved through providing welfare services delivered by the Union as one of the state led mass organisations In this way she suggests these regimes did not only aim to undermine opposition and to create the illusion of consent but they factually catered to local needs and depended on consent Based on archival material interviews and statistics *Creating Consent in Ba'athist Syria* will shed new light on mass organisations as a crucial institution of Ba'athist state building and more broadly the construction of the Asad regimes *A History of Modern Italy* Anthony L. Mahaney, 2024-04-18 This book explores the evolution of Spanish feminism in the context of European feminisms and institutions from the 1960s to recent times Beginning with Secci n Femenina the official Francoist women s organization *Feminism National Identity and European Integration in Modern Spain* traces the interplay between Spanish women s policy and international policymaking In some cases as with the Secci n Femenina championed Law of Political Rights Ley de Derechos in 1961 Spanish women s policy at least appeared more progressive than what Western democracies offered notable at a time when Spain was considered backward After Franco s death in 1975 Spain s democratic transition seemingly consolidated forward thinking women s policy with a Constitution that guaranteed equality of the sexes in 1978 and with the creation of a national bureau charged with crafting women s policy the Instituto de la Mujer Women s Institute in 1983 Yet feminists found themselves marginalized in Spanish political decision making as Kathryn L Mahaney argues so successfully in this study Mahaney reveals that women ultimately influenced domestic policy not by acting within national networks but by leveraging European connections particularly after Spain joined the European Economic Community EEC in 1986 The book shows that Spanish feminists worked through the EEC to gain international approval of policies that had met domestic opposition and did so by representing them as necessary litmus tests of nations democratic integrity Their proposals were shaped by the specific context of Spanish feminism but also by Spanish debates about what rights democracies should grant women and what equality in a post fascist nation should encompass This ground breaking study explains that in turn these processes shaped both Spain s and the European Union s much prized self
