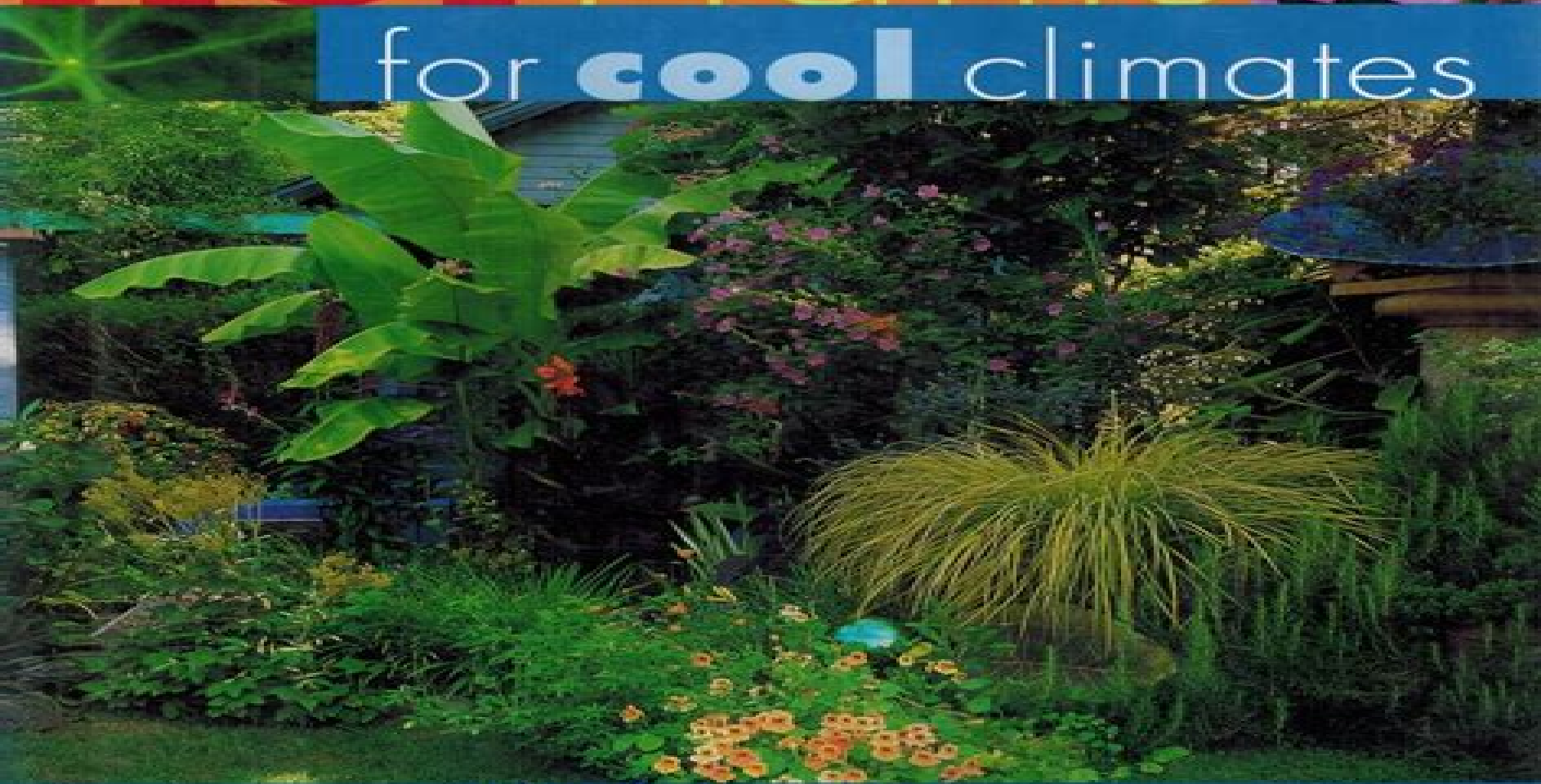
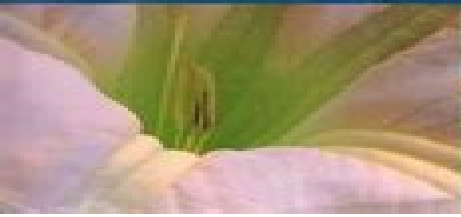

Thus began the art of garden making. Many volumes have been written on every applicable subject discussed in this and similar publications. A number of public gardens are currently referred to as botanical and zoological gardens. Population density and the public's desires and expectations, as well as financial requirements, are among the reasons for some major city parks such as Golden Gate in San Francisco, Central Park in New York City and Lincoln Park in Chicago, which integrate botanical or zoological divisions as well as museums and recreational facilities.
