Economy and Architecture addresses a timely critical and much debated topic in both its historical and contemporary dimensions. The book addresses the challenges of practicing architecture within the strictures of contemporary economies grounded on the fundamental definition of economy as the well managed household derived from the Greek *oikonomia* *oikos* house and *nemein* manage. The diverse enquiries of the study are structured around the following key questions: How do we define our economies? How are the values of architecture negotiated among the various actors involved? How do we manage the production of a good architecture within any particular system? How does political economy frame and influence architecture? The majority of examples are taken from current or recent architectural practice, historical examples which include John Evelyn's villa, Blenheim Palace, John Ruskin's Venice, and early twentieth century Paris place the debates within an extended critical perspective.
