The **distributive property** of multiplication over addition states:  $a(b+c) = a \cdot b + a \cdot c$  or a(b+c) = ab + ac. The same is true for subtraction:  $a(b-c) = a \cdot b - a \cdot c$  or a(b-c) = ab - ac.
