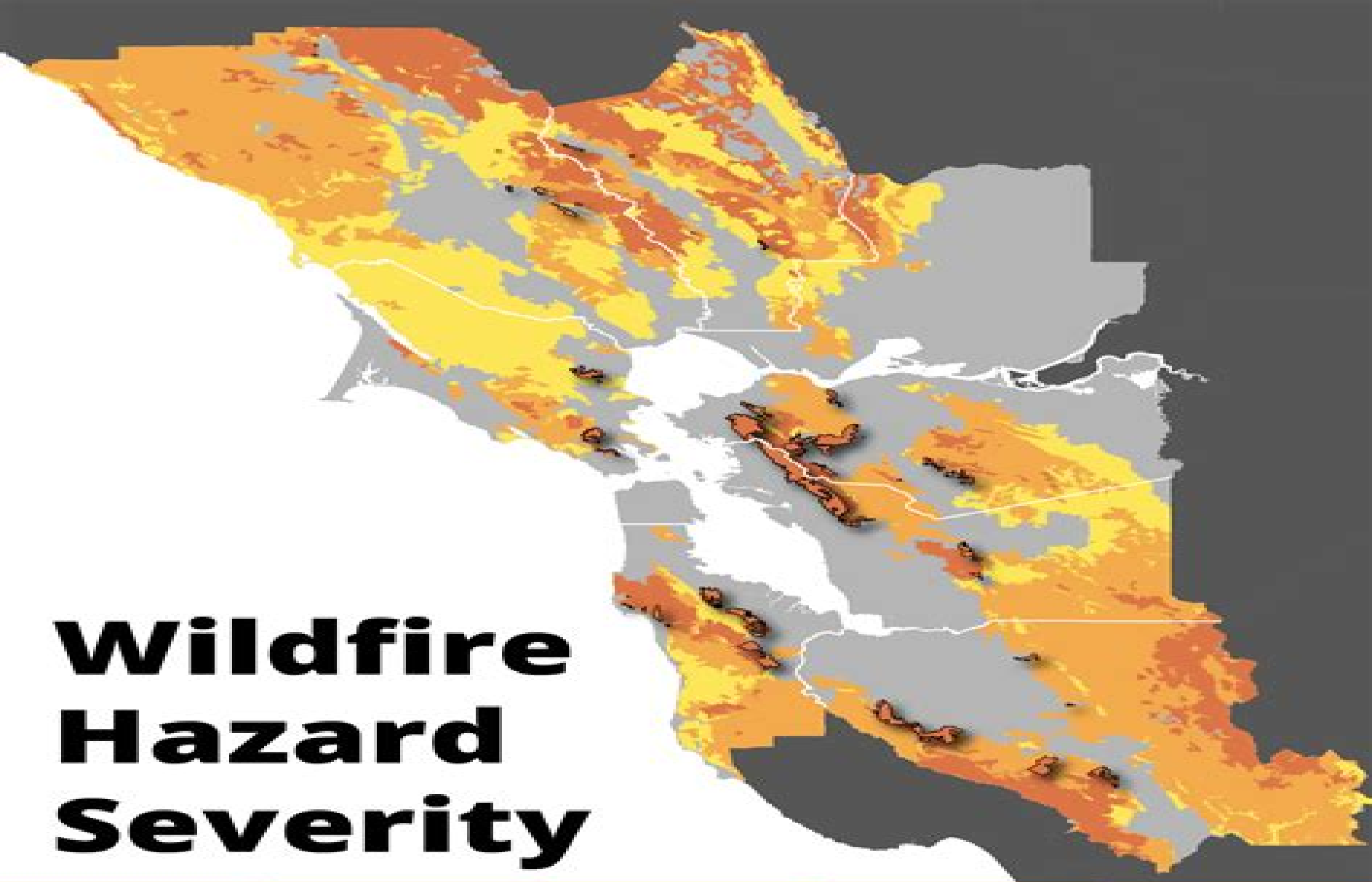

In order to ensure environmental sustainability a

better understanding of natural disasters and their impacts is essential. There is currently a lack of such feedback which constitutes a serious deficiency in the reduction of environmental hazards. This book emphasises methodological approaches and procedures of the three main components in the study of environmental hazards namely forecasting, nowcasting, before monitoring, during and assessment after based on geoinformatic technologies and data and simulation through examples and case studies. These are considered within the risk management framework and in particular within the three components of risk assessment namely risk identification, risk estimation and risk evaluation. This approach is a contemporary and innovative procedure and constitutes current research in the field of environmental hazards.
