natural product drugs from animal and mineral sources Western European and Islamic medicine considered Dioscorides the foremost authority on drugs just as Hippocrates is regarded as the Father of Medicine They saw him point the way but only described the end of his finger despite the fact that in the sixteenth century alone there were over one hundred books published on him If he had explained what he thought to be self evident then science especially chemistry and medicine would almost certainly have developed differently In this culmination of over twenty years of research Riddle employs modern science and anthropological studies innovatively and cautiously to demonstrate the substance to Dioscorides authority in medicine
