They can be found at Neolithic and Sardinian and Hopi rock art sites in Hindu temples and Taoist shrines bordering Minoan frescoes and in Roman mosaics. They have been carved into rocks turf and wood engraved in metal laid out in stones woven in reeds set in tiles painted and drawn.
