- **Osteoblasts:** make bone matrix
- **Osteoclasts:** break down bone matrix
- **Osteocytes:** mature bone
- **Osteon:** cylindrical structure of bone/haversian system
- **Resorption**

Types of Bones

- **Axial vs Appendicular Skeleton**
- **Long:** such as arms and legs***
- **Short:** wrists and ankles, carpals, and tarsals
- **Flat:** ribs, shoulder, and hip bones
- **Irregular:** found w/in spine such as vertebrae
