#### 1.-BACKGROUND

The factor structure of the MBSRQ is under debate due to the limitations of previous research methods such as principal component analysis (PCA)<sup>2</sup>. Although the fourdimensional 38-item version of the MBSRQ is widely used in Spain<sup>2</sup>, recent studies suggest a more efficient two-factor 15-version item<sup>2</sup>. However, no studies have directly compared both versions with a Spanish population sample.
