how accountable bureaucracies actually work and proposes that mental healthcare research should not just evaluate new interventions but should investigate new ways of organising This book is written with a non specialist audience in mind as it is intended for all with a stake in mental healthcare research and practice It is also for those with an interest in ethnographic methods as a novel way of deploying ethnography autoethnography and coproduced ethnography to address clinically important research topics
