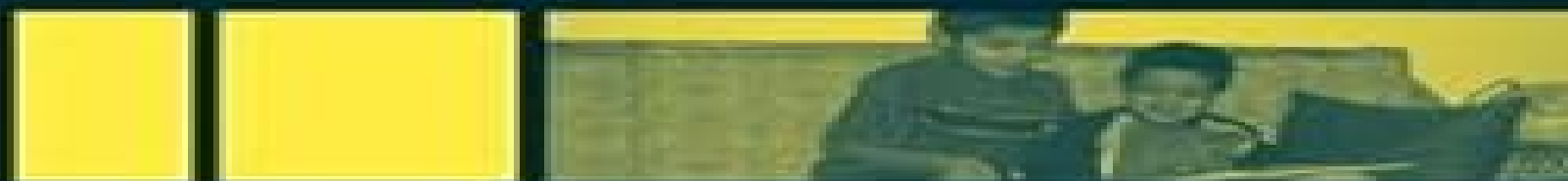

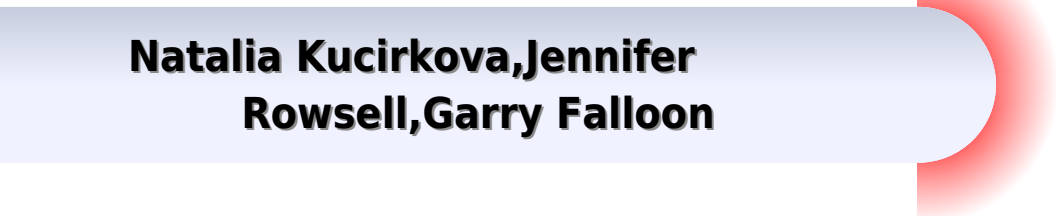

Many teachers are increasingly concerned with how to best support the learning of the rising numbers of bilingual learners in schools, particularly those children who are new to English and therefore cannot yet communicate with the teacher or their peers in their first language during the silent period. This book offers an alternative insight to that which is most commonly available to teachers and researchers: as instead of examining language acquisition purely from a linguistic approach, it explores the learning that is occurring through a sociocultural lens and even more significantly from the young child's perspective: the worm's eye view. Investigated through the experiences of young bilingual learners, this allows the reader to make sense of the making of meaning that occurs when the child cannot make sense of his/her new world nor communicate verbally in the language of instruction in the classroom.
