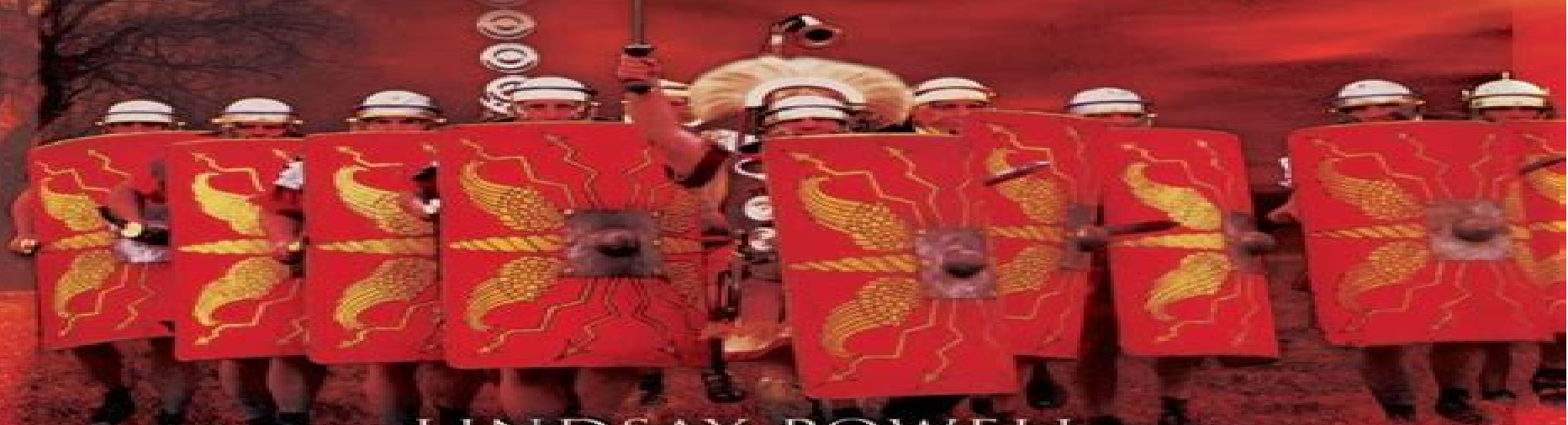

Romans It was also the scene of bitter fighting during the Civil Wars that led to the end of the Republic and the beginning of the Empire with the great battles between Julius Caesar and the sons of Pompey as well as the final defeat of Quintus Sertorius who had held out in Spain for over a decade There was also three years of struggle by the Emperor Augustus trying to quell the revolts of the Cantabrian tribes Lastly Spain as with other parts of the Empire had to battle the barbarian incursions Those by the Mauri came from the south while from the north poured the Goths At first they became foederati of the Romans fighting for the Empire in exchange for land but when Rome ended up collapsing the Goths occupied the space of power left by the Romans This though did not mean the disappearance of the Hispano Romans but rather that they began to collaborate with the new occupiers of Hispania and their influence and legacy can still be felt today This is seen not only through its language and culture but also through a multitude of public works and an enormous amount of historical heritage that we can still enjoy
