In Calvin the distinction between law and gospel was foundational for the depiction of biblical vision of eschatology in the Garden of Eden before the Fall and under the Old

Covenant However the exponents of the Federal Vision deny any validity of the distinction between law and gospel in hermeneutics theology and practice while they identify themselves with those of Calvin In that sense we may identify the Federal Vision not with the Protestant Reformation and Calvin but as consistent monocovenantalism in which they deny the distinction between law and gospel and apply that monocovenantal principle consistently to their understandings of hermeneutics soteriology the doctrine of double predestination and sacramental theology Living into Community Christine D.
