God's Eugenicist Andrés Horacio Reggiani,2007 The temptations of a new genetically informed eugenics and of a revived faith based world wide political stance this study of the interaction of science religion politics and the culture of celebrity in twentieth century Europe and America offers a fascinating and important contribution to the history of this movement The author looks at the career of French born physician and Nobel Prize winner Alexis Carrel 1873 1944 as a way of understanding the popularization of eugenics through religious faith scientific expertise cultural despair and right wing politics in the 1930s and 1940s Carrel was among the most prestigious experimental surgeons of his time who also held deeply illiberal views In *Man the Unknown* 1935 he endorsed fascism and called for the elimination of the unfit The book became a huge international success largely thanks to its promotion by Readers Digest as well as by the author s friendship with Charles Lindbergh In 1941 he went into the service of the French pro German regime of Vichy which appointed him to head an institution of eugenics research His influence was remarkable affecting radical

Islamic groups as well as Le Pen's Front National that celebrated him as the founder of ecology **The Critic** ,1889

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
