have not done in depth studies of map samplers until recently Stitching the World is an interdisciplinary work drawing on cartography needlework and material culture This book for the first time provides a critical analysis of these artefacts showing that they offer significant insights into both eighteenth and nineteenth century geographic thought and cartography in the USA and the UK and into the development of female education
