Groth, 2017-04-17 Slavery and Freedom in the Mid Hudson Valley focuses on the largely forgotten history of slavery in New York and the African American freedom struggle in the central Hudson Valley prior to the Civil War Slaves were central actors in the drama that unfolded in the region during the Revolution and they waged a long and bitter battle for freedom during the decades that followed Slavery in the countryside was more oppressive than slavery in urban environments and the agonizingly slow pace of abolition constraints of rural poverty and persistent racial hostility in the rural communities also presented formidable challenges to free black life in the central Hudson Valley Michael E Groth explores how Dutchess County s black residents overcame such obstacles to establish independent community institutions engage in political activism and fashion a vibrant racial consciousness in antebellum New York By drawing attention to the African American experience in the rural Mid Hudson Valley this book provides new perspectives on slavery and emancipation in New York black community formation and the nature of black identity in the Early Republic *A Secret Society History of the Civil War* Mark A. Lause, 2011-12-01 This unique history of the Civil War considers the impact of nineteenth century American secret societies on the path to as well as the course of the war Beginning with the European secret societies that laid the groundwork for Freemasonry in the United States Mark A Lause analyzes how the Old World s traditions influenced various underground groups and movements in America particularly George Lippard s Brotherhood of the Union an American attempt to replicate the political secret societies that influenced the European revolutions of 1848 Lause traces the Brotherhood s various manifestations the most conspicuous being the Knights of the Golden Circle out of which developed the Ku Klux Klan and the Confederate secret groups through which John Wilkes Booth and others attempted to undermine the Union Lause profiles the key leaders of these organizations with special focus on George Lippard Hugh Forbes and George Washington Lafayette Bickley Antebellum secret societies ranged politically from those with progressive or even revolutionary agendas to those that pursued conservative or oppressive goals This book shows how in the years leading up to the Civil War these clandestine organizations exacerbated existing sectional tensions in the United States Lause s research indicates that the pervasive influence of secret societies may have played a part in key events such as the Freesoil movement the beginning of the Republican party John Brown s raid on Harpers Ferry Lincoln s election and the Southern secession process of 1860 1861 This exceptional study encompasses both white and African American secret society involvement revealing the black fraternal experience in antebellum America as well as the clandestine operations that provided assistance to escaped slaves via the Underground Railroad Unraveling these pervasive and extensive networks of power and influence *A Secret Society History of the Civil War* demonstrates that antebellum secret

League Baseball 1920 1948 Some experts maintain that the quality of play was equal to that of the American and National Leagues Some believe the Negro Leagues should be part of Major League Baseball's official record and that more Negro League players should be in the Hall of Fame Skeptics contend that while many players could be rated highly NL organizations were minor league at best Drawing on the most comprehensive data available including stats from more than 2 000 interracial games this study finds that black baseball was very good indeed Negro leaguers beat the big leaguers more than half the time in head to head contests demonstrated stronger metrics within their own leagues and excelled when finally allowed into the majors The authors document the often duplicitous manner in which MLB has dealt with the legacy of the Negro Leagues and an appendix includes the scores and statistics from every known contest between Negro League and Major League teams

Black Litigants in the Antebellum American South Kimberly M. Welch, 2018-02-05 In the antebellum Natchez district in the heart of slave country black people sued white people in all white courtrooms They sued to enforce the terms of their contracts recover unpaid debts recuperate back wages and claim damages for assault They sued in conflicts over property and personal status And they often won Based on new research conducted in courthouse basements and storage sheds in rural Mississippi and Louisiana Kimberly Welch draws on over 1 000 examples of free and enslaved black litigants who used the courts to protect their interests and reconfigure their place in a tense society To understand their success Welch argues that we must understand the language that they used the language of property in particular to make their claims recognizable and persuasive to others and to link their status as owner to the ideal of a free autonomous citizen In telling their stories Welch reveals a previously unknown world of black legal activity one that is consequential for understanding the long history of race rights and civic inclusion in America

that the intersection of these riverboats and the environment reveals much about sectional identity in antebellum America As federal funds backed railroad construction instead of efforts to clear waterways for steamboats southerners looked to coordinate their own economic development free of national interests Steamboats and the Rise of the Cotton Kingdom offers new insights into the remarkable and significant history of transportation and commerce in the prewar South *James K. The Limits of Liberty James David Nichols,2018-07-01 The Limits of Liberty chronicles the formation of the U S Mexico border from the perspective of the mobile peoples who assisted in determining the international boundary from both sides in the mid nineteenth century In this historic and timely study James David Nichols argues against the many top down connotations that borders carry noting that the state cannot entirely dominate the process of boundary marking Even though there were many efforts on the part of the United States and Mexico to define the new international border as a limit mobile peoples continued to transgress the border and cross it with impunity Transborder migrants reimagined the dividing line as a gateway to opportunity rather than as a fence limiting their movement Runaway slaves Mexican debt peones and seminomadic Native Americans saw liberty on the other side of the line and crossed in search of greater opportunity In doing so they devised their own border epistemology that clashed with official understandings of the boundary These divergent understandings resulted in violence with the crossing of vigilantes soldiers and militias in search of fugitives and runaways The Limits of Liberty explores how the border attracted migrants from both sides and considers border crossers together whereas most treatments thus far have considered discrete social groups along the border Mining Mexican archival sources Nichols is one of the first scholars to explore the nuance of negotiation that took place between the state and mobile peoples in the formation of borders

 Ricardo Raúl Salazar Rey, 2020-11-17 Explores the legal relationships of enslaved people and their descendants during the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries in Spanish America Atlantic slavery can be overwhelming in its immensity and brutality as it involved more than 15 million souls forcibly displaced by European imperialism and consumed in building the global economy *Mastering the Law Slavery and Freedom in the Legal Ecology of the Spanish Empire* lays out the deep history of Iberian slavery explores its role in the Spanish Indies and shows how Africans and their descendants used and shaped the legal system as they established their place in Iberoamerican society during the seventeenth century Ricardo Raúl Salazar Rey places the institution of slavery and the people involved with it at the center of the creation story of Latin America Iberoamerican customs and laws and the institutions that enforced them provided a common language and a forum to resolve disputes for Spanish subjects including enslaved and freedpeople The rules through which Iberian conquerors settlers and

administrators incorporated Africans into the expanding Empire were developed out of the need of a distant crown to find an enforceable consensus Africans and their mestizo descendants in turn used and therefore molded Spanish institutions to serve their interests Salazar Rey mined extensively the archives of secular and religious courts which are full of complex disputes unexpected subversions and tactical alliances among enslaved people freedpeople and the crown The narrative unfolds around vignettes that show Afroiberians building their lives while facing exploitation and inequality enforced through violence Salazar Rey deals mostly with cases originating from Cartagena de Indias a major Atlantic port city that supported the conquest and rule of the Indies His work recovers the voices and indomitable ingenuity that enslaved people and their descendants displayed when engaging with the Spanish legal ecology The social relationships animating the case studies represent the broader African experience in the Americas during the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries The Archive of Fear Christina Zwarg,2020 The Archive of Fear explores the trauma theory in relation to U S discussions of slavery and abolition before and after the Civil War
