What is counter-messaging?

A message that disrupts harmful content by offering a more proactive, truthful message to address the core fear or falsehood being spread. For example:

THEY SAY	THEY MEAN	WE SAY
"She's radical."	She doesn't care about you.	She's spent her career helping those in need.
"She'll do anything for political power."	She didn't earn her place.	She has a proven track record.
"She's not 'really' Black."	Her nomination isn't historic or meaningful.	She's the next part of a generational legacy of civil rights leaders.

Before responding: three factors to consider

1 REACH

To what extent has a new claim or piece of content broken out of its original echo chamber? Is it reaching the people we care about? 2 IMPACT

To what extent do we care if it has broken out of its echo chamber? Is it going to change the offline situation at all? Who does it impact? 3 RESPONSE

What's the best plan for responding to impacted audiences? How do we mitigate the threat of amplification?
