Due to the historical context in which it was created such architecture remains ambiguous On the one hand the wider public associates it with the legacy of the unpleasant period of the real socialist economic regime Yet on the other hand it is also a manifestation of social modernization and the promotion of a significant proportion of the population This book focuses particularly on concrete heritage a legacy of modernist architecture in Central and Eastern Europe and it was this material that enabled their rebuilding after World War II and modernization during the following decades The authors search for the value of modernist architecture and using case studies from Poland Bulgaria Northern Macedonia Lithuania and Slovenia verify to what extent this heritage is embedded in the local socio economic milieu and becomes a basis for creating new values.
