Mediterranean Erica Ferg,2020-01-16 Geography Religion Gods and Saints in the Eastern Mediterranean explores the influence of geography on religion and highlights a largely unknown story of religious history in the Eastern Mediterranean In the Levant agricultural communities of Jews Christians and Muslims jointly venerated and largely shared three important saints or holy figures Jewish Elijah Christian St George and Muslim al Khi r These figures share peculiar characteristics such as associations with rain greenness fertility and storms Only in the Eastern Mediterranean are Elijah St George and al Khi r shared between religious communities or characterized by these same agricultural attributes attributes that also were shared by regional religious figures from earlier time periods such as the ancient Near Eastern Storm god Baal Hadad and Levantine Zeus This book tells the story of how that came to be and suggests that the figures share specific characteristics over a very long period of time because these motifs were shaped by the geography of the region Ultimately this book suggests that regional geography has influenced regional religion that Judaism Christianity and Islam are not historically or textually speaking separate religious traditions even if Jews Christians and Muslims are members of distinct religious communities and that shared religious practices between members of these and other local religious communities are not unusual Instead shared practices arose out of a common geographical environment and an interconnected religious heritage and are a natural historical feature of religion in the Eastern Mediterranean This volume will be of interest to students of ancient Near Eastern religions Judaism Christianity Islam sainthood agricultural communities in the ancient Near East Middle Eastern religious and cultural history and the relationships between geography and religion

Rethinking the Qur'ān in Late Antiquity Juan Cole,2025-02-17 How the Qur n reflects on and responds to the regional cultural religious and political currents swirling in Western Arabia and neighboring areas during the great war 603 630 between the Roman and Sasanian empires The book approaches the Qur n through six case studies The first two consider the era 200 800 CE which classicist Peter Brown dubbed late antiquity The second two contextualize quranic stories and tropes in the era of Herakleios and Khosrow II The final pair consider issues in how the Qur n was constituted both physically and stylistically and also sets these processes in their late antique context The book treats the constitution of the quranic text first physically and then rhetorically The use in the Qur n of the technique of narrative apostrophe is for the first time subjected to a concerted analysis These themes are all united by a concern to understand better issues in why the Qur n makes certain narrative choices how the narrative changes over time and how it articulates with other texts and perspectives

Hosea's God

Mason D. Lancaster,2023-08-11 The book of Hosea is a labyrinth of juxtaposed images for God and God s people with such disparate metaphors as God the devouring lion and God the reviving dew In Hosea s God A Metaphorical Theology Mason D

Lancaster demonstrates that recent advances in metaphor theory help untangle these divergent portrayals of God. He analyzes fifteen metaphor clusters in Hosea 4:14 individually, then discerns patterns and reversals between the clusters. Finally, respecting the ancient value for emphasizing individual aspects of a depiction over a homogenized picture of the whole, the book identifies five characteristics of God prominent among the metaphors of Hosea. Based on this analysis, Lancaster asserts that Hosea's metaphorical depiction of Yahweh ultimately derives from the primacy of Yahweh's fidelity to Israel.

We Are Being Transformed M. David Litwa, 2012-02-22 Can Pauline soteriology be categorized as a form of deification? This book attempts to answer this question by keen attention to the Greco-Roman world. It provides the first full-scale history of research on the topic. It is also the first work to fully treat the basic historical questions relating to deification. Namely: what is deity in the Greco-Roman world?
