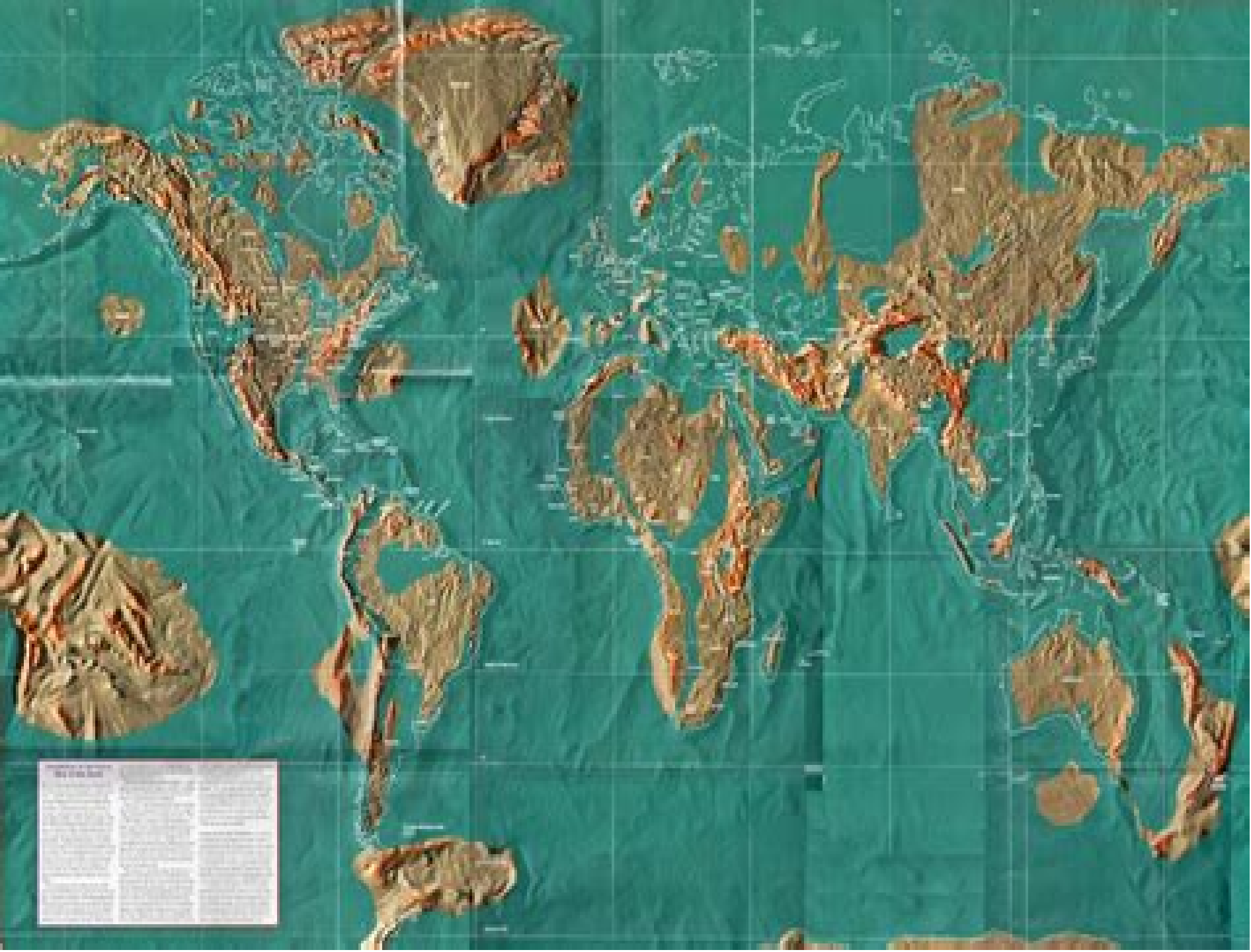




THE WORLD'S LARGEST OCEANIC TRENCH

It is named after the Spanish ship *Mariano*, which was the first to explore the trench in 1875. The trench is a result of the subduction of the Pacific Plate under the Philippine Sea Plate. The Mariana Trench is home to a variety of unique and exotic life forms, including the Mariana snailfish, which is the deepest-living vertebrate known to science. The trench is also a major source of deep-sea minerals, including manganese nodules and hydrothermal vents.
