These rival views can be seen as the horns of the Logipthro dilemma: either logic depends on God's will, in which case special revelation would no longer be communicable, or logic is independent of God, in which case core claims of classical theism, for example, that God is the only independent being, would be violated. The best way to escape both of these horns, according to McGlothlin, is to adopt the nonstandard form of theistic logical dependence.
