

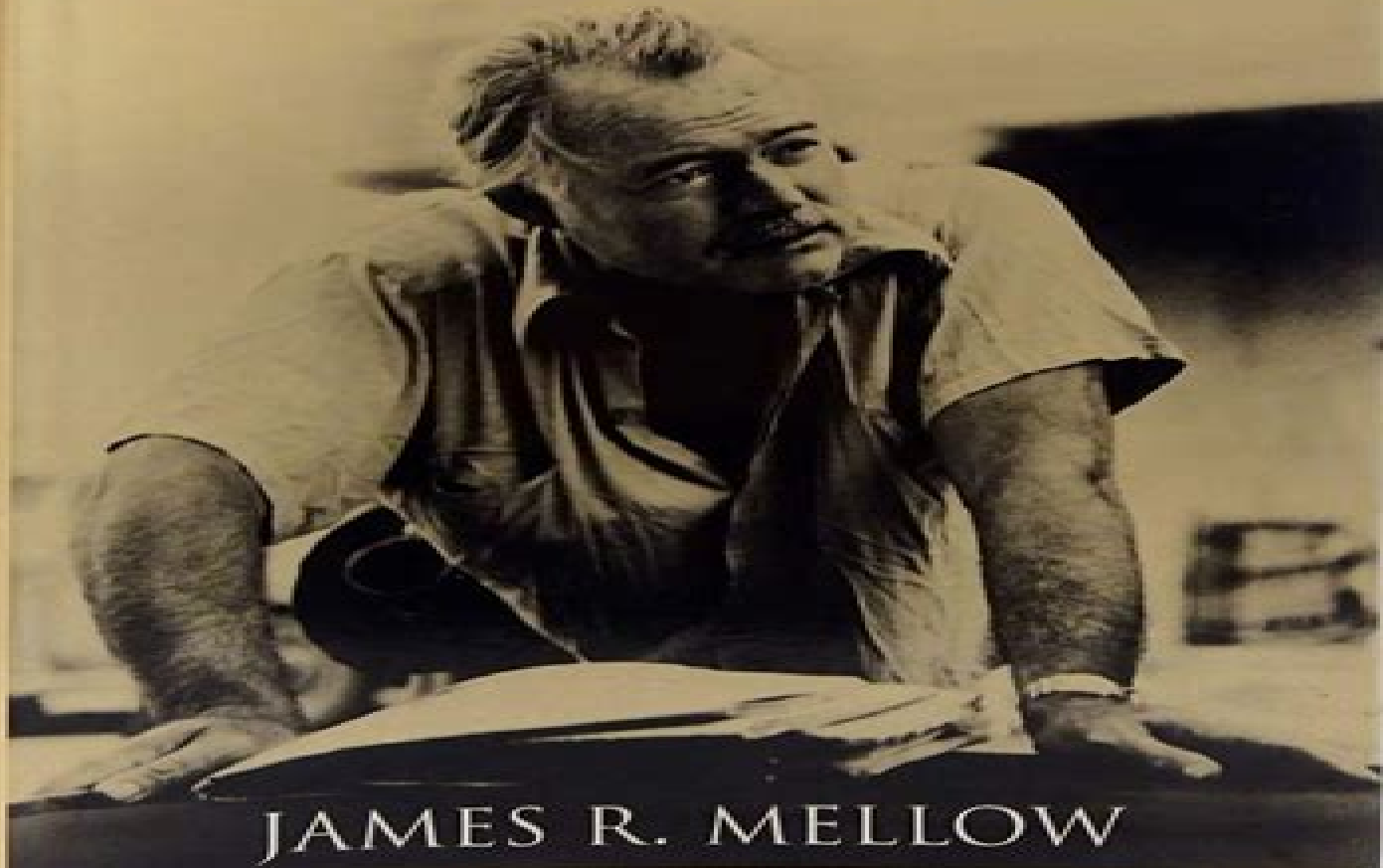

Garber, 2000 In this witty and scrupulously researched book Garber examines bisexuality through a variety of critical lenses cultural literal and psychological She explores what normal is and points out how difficult it is to make claims about someone's sexuality of photos Modernism and Tradition in Ernest Hemingway's In Our Time Matthew Stewart, 2001 The volume of collected short stories and vignettes In Our Time was Ernest Hemingway's first commercial publication Its appearance in 1925 launched the full fledged literary career of this century's most famous American fiction writer And while other later works of Hemingway have eclipsed In Our Time's fame none of Hemingway's subsequent works would again carry the degree of experimentation found in this distinctly modernist masterwork Modernism and Tradition in Ernest Hemingway's In Our Time A Guide for Students and Readers is a well paced lucidly written handbook intended to guide university students and teaching faculty towards a better understanding of this complex work It provides a reading of each story and vignette while simultaneously stressing the status of In Our Time as a discrete volume Included are discussions of the book's biographical and historical background and considerations of Hemingway's prose style theories of writing formal achievements his literary mentors and influences and the relation between In Our Time and his later works Matthew C Stewart is Associate Professor of Humanities and Rhetoric at Boston University *Hemingway's Cats* Carlene Fredericka Brennen, 2015-09-01 Ernest Hemingway always had cats as companions from the ones he adored as a child in Illinois and Michigan to the more than 30 he had as an adult in Paris Key West Cuba and Idaho All are chronicled and most are pictured here along with revelations of how they fit into the many twists and turns of his life and loves In 1943 Ernest Hemingway living in the Finca in Cuba with his third wife and eleven cats wrote to his first wife One cat just leads to another The place is so damned big it doesn't really seem as though there were many cats until you see them all moving like a mass migration at feeding time He called the cats purr factories and love sponges who soaked up love in return for comfort and companionship He gave each a name that suited its character including F Puss Fatso Friendless Feather Kitty Princessa Furhouse Uncle Woofer and his last cat in Idaho Big Boy Peterson You'll also meet his nine dogs a cow and a young great horned owl that he rescued not long before his death Hemingway's Cats reveals a softer side to the writer's character than is usually portrayed by the macho image of the hunter and fisherman He sought the cats comfort in times of loneliness and stress and he featured some of them in his writings particularly in A Moveable Feast Islands in the Stream The Garden of Eden and True at First Light all written late in his life and as close to autobiography as he came **Hemingway's Art of Revision** John Beall, 2024-05 In Hemingway's Art

of Revision The Making of the Short Fiction John Beall examines in close detail two of the author's vignettes from the first version of *In Our Time* and ten of his short stories with an extensive focus on manuscripts and typescripts as part of a broader examination of how Ernest Hemingway crafted his distinctive prose through a rigorous process of revision The first three chapters discuss the influence of Hemingway's three most important modernist mentors Ezra Pound James Joyce and Gertrude Stein The first chapter focuses on Pound's influence as the editor of the *Inquest Series* of which Hemingway's *In Our Time* was the final publication The second chapter examines the affinities between Joyce's *The Sisters* and Hemingway's *Indian Camp* In particular Beall develops the case for Joyce's influence on Hemingway's decision to revise the story to maintain the reader's focus on young Nick Adams's point of view in his first encounter with death Chapter three explores Hemingway's revisions of *Cat in the Rain* as reflecting the influence of Stein's novellas and sketches as well as that of Joyce's stories and novels The remaining chapters delve into the artistry of Hemingway's extensive revisions in later masterpieces from *Big Two Hearted River* to *Fathers and Sons* Beall's discussion of *Big Two Hearted River* shows that Hemingway's revisions were not simply cuts and omissions but included several paragraphs that he added to slow down the narrative and represent Nick Adams's careful observations of a kingfisher and trout as he watched their shadows on the river The chapter on *The Battler* and *The Killers* explores the extent to which Hemingway's revisions brought racial conflicts to the forefront of each story and portrayed Bugs and Sam as guides for Nick Adams A subsequent reading of the story *Now I Lay Me* shows that in rewriting the story Hemingway developed his portrait of Nick Adams as a writer making up imaginary rivers to cope with the traumas of childhood and war A chapter on *A Way You'll Never Be* focuses on how Hemingway's revisions developed crucial story elements including Nick's interior monologues manic lecture about grasshoppers and wacky sense of humor that showed the character restoring a sense of emotional balance despite his memories of being wounded in World War I Subsequent chapters on *Fathers and Sons* *Indian Camp* *Hills Like White Elephants* *The Gambler* *the Nun* and *the Radio* and the concluding chapter in part focused on drafts of *The Snows of Kilimanjaro* offer new discussions of the author's process of revision based on his manuscripts and typescripts published in the Hemingway Library Edition In the end by drawing attention to the meticulous edits additions and deletions that helped shape these texts Beall reveals how extensively and richly Hemingway revised his drafts while composing some of his most powerful short fiction Hemingway's *Art of Revision* gives a detailed view of a great prose stylist at work

The Impossible Craft Scott Donaldson, 2015-02-23 In *The Impossible Craft* Scott Donaldson explores the rocky territory of literary biography the most difficult that biographers try to navigate Writers are accustomed to controlling the narrative and notoriously opposed to allowing intruders on their turf They make bonfires of their papers encourage others to destroy correspondence write their own autobiographies and appoint family or friends to protect their reputations as official biographers Thomas Hardy went so far as to compose his own life story to be published after his death while falsely assigning authorship to his widow After a brief background sketch of the

magazines 1934 1935 and decided to revise all the tales into one novel Yet the melding of the three stories along with the intervening story of Richard Gordon created a novel lacking in unity Hemingway even admitted that *To Have and Have Not* was a procedural error Baker xv and his least gratifying book Baker 205 The novel was crafted during a time in Hemingways life that experts describe as an interim period of artistic regression between his better glory days Baker xvi The start of the Spanish Civil War also influenced Hemingways time and focus on the novel in that the main character as an individual comes to share the same fate as the oppressed proletarians of his society Meyers 267 Hemingway worked and reworked with the manuscript even relying on the unbiased editorial eyes of trusted friends Mellow 485 until its final publication by Scribner in 1937 It opened to critical reviews which considered the work to be an anti capitalist stance against the U S government with Marxist undertones and as a novel divided against itself telling multiple stories which just didnt cohere as a single novel Mellow 488 Baker 205 206
