Online Service: Real-time information - ✓ This service is used to get up to date information

Online Service: Commerce - ✓ This service involves business - buying, selling, and money services such as banking

Online Service: Government - ✓ This service involves public services, such as government bodies, like the DVLA and local council

VLE - ✓ Virtual Learning Environment

Pay-per-click Online Advertising - ✓ A model where the website owner hosts an advert and earns money every time a user clicks on it

Banner Ads - ✓ Annoying ads that pop up and try to catch the users attention

An advantage of file compression - ✓ Saving memory space on computers

File compression Index - ✓ The last item in a compressed file, contains the information needed to expand the files to their original size

File compress Algorithm - ✓ Used to calculate how to make the file smaller

Standalone software - ✓ Installed onto the computer

Online software - ✓ Accessed over the internet through a web browser

Online backup - ✓ Saving files onto external servers

Levels of access - ✓ When different users can access different areas of a school network

File permissions: Read only - ✓ Can look at the document but make no changes

File permissions: Read/Write - ✓ Can look at a document and make changes

File permissions: Full control - ✓ Can do anything with the document, including deleting it
