Context

- Science is "Theory of Evolution" was controversial, and some Hyde is presented as an atavistic creature. It made him more aware of the human condition.
- Victorian era fascinated by the supernatural and obsessed with Victorian society and its progress, contrasting the dangers of the repression of desires in order to obtain respectability.
- Victorian era a Victorian upbringing which meant the secret and was a repression, which influenced the novel.
- The Victorian era is a period of rapid change, bringing fear of the unknown about what Hyde is, as a primitive species, seemed even more out of place.

- Jekyll and Hyde are binary opposites, suggesting we can only understand Hyde's evilness by understanding the goodness in Jekyll.
- The nature of their relationship gives the novel its power.
- Jekyll appears to be a good, respectable, responsible gentleman whereas Hyde is "pure evil".
- Jekyll behaves in a way that is socially acceptable as he is aware of how people view him, contrasting Hyde who is uncontrollable and acts with strongly immoral behaviour.
- "He was terrified utterly over the child's body and felt her screaming"
- This is the first insight into the evilness of Hyde.
- The juxtaposition of the words "terrified" and "screaming" shows the extent of how easily Hyde acts in this way.
- Children are seen as innocent and therefore it emphasises how immoral these actions are, and yet he shows no remorse or remorse.
- "There is something wrong with his appearance, something distasteful, something downright detestable"
- Repetition of the phrase "something" emphasises the obscurity as Hyde escapes description and is left to the imagination of the reader.
 - This is important because it gives a personal connection with the reader which demonstrates how there is an evil side, the Hyde, in everyone, which links to Stevenson's upbringing.
- It may hint that it isn't the physical appearance of Hyde that is wrong, but his inner-self and soul which makes him appear so evil.

numbers, his brother Abel and when God asked Cain where Abel is, he replies "Am I my brothers keeper?"

- The biblical reference shows how he isn't bothered by sin as he has been examined.
- He isn't worried about following conventional beliefs but still wants a good reputation for himself.
- The non-judgemental attitude is an important characteristic for Utterson as a lawyer.

"He looks thoughtful, that there's nothing, looked singularly dull and would hardly talk with others."

- Stevenson doesn't get much attraction and displays an unusual friendship between Utterson and Jekyll.
- The statement "nothing" creates suspense from the silence - in the Victorian era, secrecy was preferred to gossip and so the friends didn't talk.
- This denotes the importance of maintaining appearances and reputation.
- Utterson is shown to be mysterious and private, perhaps suggesting he is hiding his sexuality.

"If he has Mr Hyde, he had thought, 'I shall be the dead'."

- Utterson had an obsession over Mr Hyde.
- This comment has a curious characteristic and detective mind, as he was interested in solving the mystery.
- The pun of "Hyde" for "dead" shows a more fun side of his personality.

"If it came to a trial, good names might appear."

- Utterson is concerned for Jekyll's reputation being damaged, emphasising how important it was.
- Despite knowing there was something going on, he wouldn't act on it as he doesn't want Jekyll's name to be ruined.

"An impression of such slight horror and despair, as flows the very blood of the two gentlemen."

- He experienced something very strange.
- Unexplained events, such as this one, add to the tension in gothic novels and leave part of the story to the reader's imagination.
- Utterson is extremely affected by just the "glimpse" he had seen, leaving him in "terror".

"A good deal frightened and rather inclined to be inhibited in conversation."

- Utterson was a rational gentleman and is more comfortable dealing with facts than emotions.
- He wants to try and find a rational explanation - he believes Jekyll has an illness that changed his appearance and caused him to separate himself from society.
- Despite what he has found out, he remains non-judgemental towards Jekyll's behaviour.
