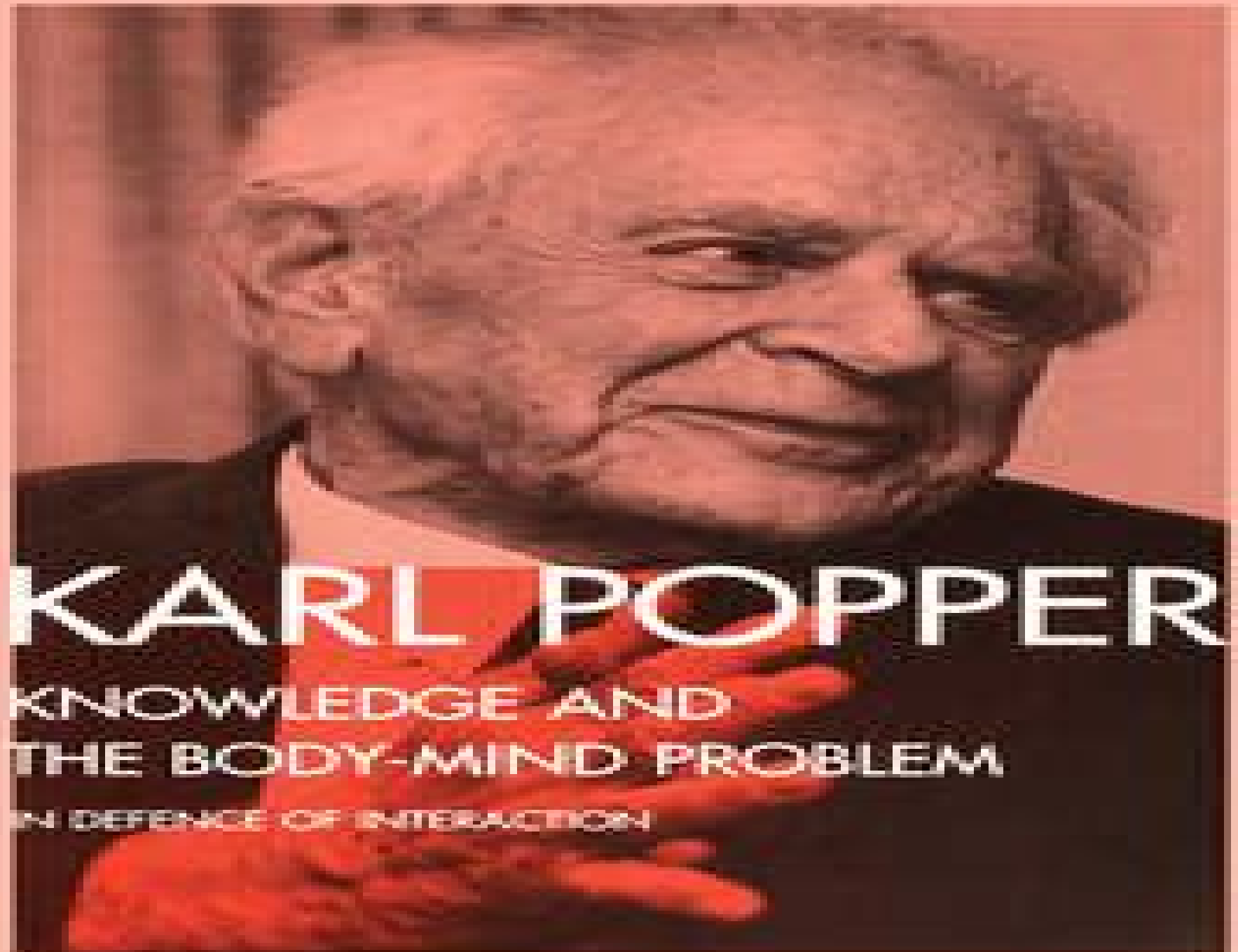

Knowledge and the Body-mind Problem Karl Raimund Popper, 1994 First published in 1994 Routledge is an imprint of Taylor Francis an informa company Knowledge and the Body-Mind Problem Karl Popper, 2013-10-28 Based upon the Kenan Lectures that Karl Popper delivered at Emory University in 1969 Knowledge and the Body Mind Problem raises problems connected with human freedom creativity rationality and the relationship between human beings and their actions These are what Popper calls big issues too big for easy answers but too important to be ignored In these lectures and in the discussions that follow them Sir Karl develops a theory of body mind interaction This theory involves evolutionary emergence human language and that realm of autonomous products of the human mind which Popper calls World 3 According to Popper consciousness emerged in the course of evolution as a kind of control system for the body like a driver is a control system for a car Objective knowledge the kind of knowledge that is found in books and libraries then emerged in the course of evolution as a higher level control system for the mind Simply put objective knowledge is the mind s control system for critical problem solving In this way full consciousness the kind of consciousness that humans can have is anchored in World 3 and is closely linked to human language problems theories and criticism And it is mainly through this use of objective knowledge as a control system for critical problem solving that we are able to exercise our freedom creativity and rationality first by making contributions like science books and works of art to World 3 and then by using these contributions to bring about changes in Worlds 1 and 2 The Kenan Lectures were well attended and provoked lively discussions This book is published in the same informal language in which they were originally delivered and so can be easily understood by a general audience
