

Step 5

- 30 minutes: Stretching words to spell them
- Drawout a story in advance
 - Have students write and stretch-out words with you
- Students go to seats and write
 - Conferences with students during this time

Step 6

- 30 minutes: Looking in
- Read *Circusathus* to the class
- Discuss the "Whole Vacationer - Seed"
 - Vacationer = vacation
 - Seed = restaurant you ate at on vacation
- VideoConference

Step 7

- 30 minutes - Partnerships and Storytelling
- Talk about story with another person

Storytelling with a Partner

1. First partner tells the story.
2. Next the partner pictures it and asks questions.
3. First partner tells the story again, saying more!
4. Partners switch!

Step 8

- 30 minutes - Reading our Writing Like We Read Our Books
- "Today I want to teach you that writers go from being the writer to being the reader. When writers reread their own books, they read just as if they were reading a published book. Sometimes, the writer hears a mess-up and says, "Oops," and fixes that part."
 - 5 students will be the models of reading out loud and finding their mistakes
- Students all are given opportunities to be readers of their own writing.
 - Students use a pen to fix up anything they notice that needs fixing up.
