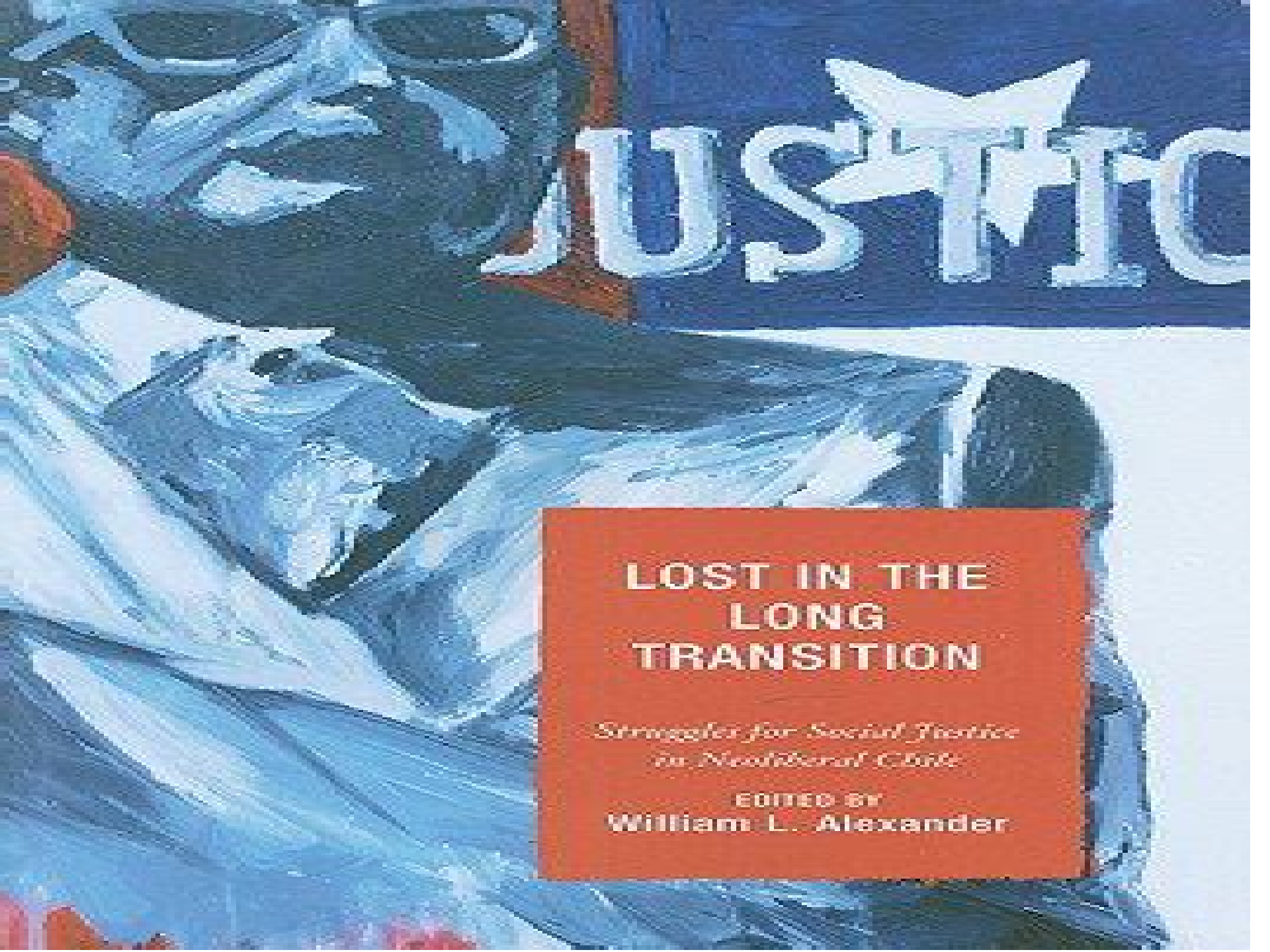

Lost in the Long Transition William L. Alexander, 2009-09-24 In *Lost in the Long Transition* a group of scholars who conducted fieldwork research in post dictatorship Chile during the transition to democracy critically examine the effects of the country's adherence to neoliberal economic development and social policies Shifting government responsibility for social services and public resources to the private sector reducing restrictions on foreign investment and promoting free trade and export production neoliberalism began during the Pinochet dictatorship and was adopted across Latin America in the 1980s With the return of civilian government the pursuit of justice and equity worked alongside a pact of compromise and an economic model that brought prosperity for some entrenched poverty for others and social consequences for all The authors who come from the disciplines of cultural anthropology history political science and geography focus their research perspectives on issues including privatization of water rights in arid lands tuberculosis and the public health crisis labor strikes and the changing role of unions the environmental and cultural impacts of export development initiatives on small scale fishing communities natural resource conservation in the private sector the political ecology of copper the fight for affordable housing homelessness and citizenship rights under the judicial system and the gender experiences of returned exiles In the years leading up to the global financial meltdown of 2008 many Latin American governments responding to inequities at home and attempting to pull themselves out of debt dependency moved away from the Chilean model This book examines the social costs of that model and the growing resistance to neoliberalism in Chile providing ethnographic details of the struggles of those excluded from its benefits This research offers a look at the lives of those whose stories may have otherwise been *Lost in the Long Transition*

Neoliberalism and Commodity Production in Mexico Thomas Weaver, James B. Greenberg, William L. Alexander, Anne Browning-Aiken, 2012-06-15 *Neoliberalism and Commodity Production in Mexico* details the impact of neoliberal practice on the production and exchange of basic resources in working class communities in Mexico Using anthropological investigations and a market driven approach contributors explain how uneven policies have undermined constitutional protections and working class interests since the Mexican Revolution of 1910 Detailed ethnographic fieldwork shows how foreign investment privatization deregulation and elimination of welfare benefits have devastated national industries and natural resources and threatened agriculture driving the campesinos and working class deeper into poverty Focusing on specific commodity chains and the

Pinochet Indira Palacios-Valladares, 2011 In recent decades many countries have implemented neoliberal reforms that have had adverse consequences for unions In Chile this process was particularly sweeping having occurred under the right wing dictatorship of General Augusto Pinochet Despite the transition to democracy in 1990 the labor relations system created by the Pinochet regime is still largely in place Although a number of works have assessed the conditions of unionism in post dictatorship Chile little attention has been paid to the firm level which is where most of the collective bargaining now takes place This book takes a qualitative approach to examining the dynamics of collective bargaining at the firm level in democratic Chile by investigating the causes of variation in the bargaining outcomes of fifty three unions in four firms in the banking manufacturing retail and telecommunications sectors It seeks to explain both variation in individual union bargaining outcomes within firms and aggregate differences in outcomes between firms The book also provides a systematic explanation of the decline of collective bargaining results among Chilean unions in general during the 1990s and early 2000s

For a Proper Home Edward Murphy, 2015-01-15 From 1967 to 1973 a period that culminated in the socialist project of Salvador Allende nearly 400 000 low income Chileans illegally seized parcels of land on the outskirts of Santiago Remarkably today almost all of these individuals live in homes with property titles As Edward Murphy shows this transformation came at a steep price through an often violent political and social struggle that continues to this day In analyzing the causes and consequences of this struggle Murphy reveals a crucial connection between homeownership and understandings of proper behavior and governance This link between property and propriety has been at the root of a powerful contested urban politics central to both social activism and urban development projects Through projects of reform revolution and reaction a right to housing and

homeownership has been a significant symbol of governmental benevolence and poverty reduction Under Pinochet's neoliberalism subsidized housing and slum eradication programs displaced many squatters while awarding them homes of their own This process in addition to ongoing forms of activism has permitted the vast majority of squatters to live in homes with property titles a momentous change of the past half century This triumph is tempered by the fact that today the urban poor struggle with high levels of unemployment and underemployment significant debt and a profoundly segregated and hostile urban landscape They also find it more difficult to mobilize than in the past and as homeowners they can no longer rally around the cause of housing rights Citing cultural theorists from Marx to Foucault Murphy directly links the importance of home ownership and property rights among Santiago's urban poor to definitions of Chilean citizenship and propriety He explores how the deeply embedded liberal belief system of individual property ownership has shaped political social and physical landscapes in the city His approach sheds light on the role that social movements and the gendered contours of home life have played in the making of citizenship It also illuminates processes through which squatters have received legally sanctioned homes of their own a phenomenon of critical importance in cities throughout much of Latin America and the Global South

Art Against Dictatorship Jacqueline Adams, 2013-09-15 Art can be a powerful avenue of resistance to oppressive governments During the dictatorship of Augusto Pinochet in Chile some of the country's least powerful citizens impoverished women living in Santiago's shantytowns spotlighted the government's failings and use of violence by creating and selling arpilleras appliquéd pictures in cloth that portrayed the unemployment poverty and repression that they endured their work to make ends meet and their varied forms of protest Smuggled out of Chile by human rights organizations the arpilleras raised international awareness of the Pinochet regime's abuses while providing income for the arpillera makers and creating a network of solidarity between the people of Chile and sympathizers throughout the world Using the Chilean arpilleras as a case study this book explores how dissident art can be produced under dictatorship when freedom of expression is absent and repression rife and the consequences of its production for the resistance and for the artists Taking a sociological approach based on interviews participant observation archival research and analysis of a visual database Jacqueline Adams examines the emergence of the arpilleras and then traces their journey from the workshops and homes in which they were made to the human rights organizations that exported them and on to sellers and buyers abroad as well as in Chile She then presents the perspectives of the arpillera makers and human rights organization staff who discuss how the arpilleras strengthened the resistance and empowered the women who made them
