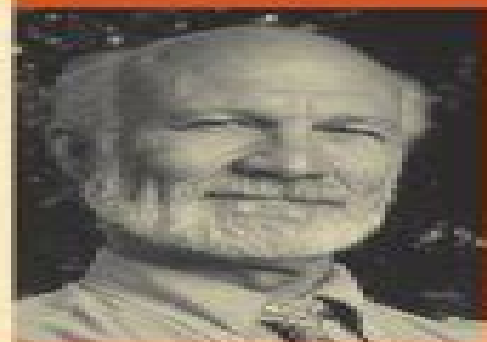

Gregory Jones, Reinhard Hütter, 2005 Robert N Bellah David B Burrell George Lindbeck and others honor and engage the work of Stanley Hauerwas Theology in the Service of the Church Timothy George, Eric Farrel Mason, 2008 This title bridges the chasm between church and academy This volume celebrates the life and work of Fisher H Humphreys a noted Baptist theologian whose teachings and writings have shaped several generations of pastors missionaries and theological students Humphreys has said about his own life s work My theology is church theology I do thinking about God in the fellowship of the church Since 1990 Humphreys has taught systematic theology at Beeson Divinity School of Samford University following an even longer tenure on the faculty of New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary Written by Humphreys colleagues and friends the essays here illuminate various aspects of the theologian s calling from the standpoint of specific theological disciplines and from the intersection of theology with other areas of Christian life and thought In this way Fisher Humphreys self understanding of his own vocation as a theologian of the church is commended and the importance of thinking clearly and faithfully about God in the fellowship of the church is seen to be a vital component in the life of the faith The Necessity of Witness Ariaan Baan, 2015-08-17 The role of witness is a recurring theme in the work of Stanley Hauerwas it is through enacting the truth in a world of lies through seeking peace in a world of violence that witnesses show who God is who we are and what the world is like The Necessity of Witness is a study of Hauerwas and his fascinating but complex understanding of witness Ariaan W Baan argues that Hauerwas s approach makes a significant contribution to current debates in systematic theology on the relation between truth and life Reading Hauerwas can be a precarious adventure His rhetoric is overwhelming but his argument is not always crystal clear and carefully formulated With the help of semiotic and philosophical analysis and biblical exegesis Baan articulates Hauerwas s intuitions fills some of the gaps in his argumentation and discloses hidden biases The results of this analysis sometimes surprise Baan notes that unexpected pericopes in Scripture such as Isaiah and Revelation support Hauerwas s account of witness and concludes that his work offers insight into how in our late modern society such diverse groups as martyrs and pop stars offer implicit witness through their lives **Safeguarding the Stranger** Jayme R Reaves, 2017-08-31 In our troubled world protective hospitality is tragically necessary and requires informed shared action and belief on behalf of the threatened other In Safeguarding the Stranger Jayme R Reaves argues that protective hospitality and its faith based foundations as seen in the Abrahamic traditions of Judaism Christianity and Islam merit greater theological attention Reaves shows that the practice of protective hospitality in Christianity can be enhanced by a better understanding of Jewish and Muslim practices of hospitality as well as of their codes and etiquettes related to honour Safeguarding the Stranger draws on a contextual and political theological approach informed by liberation and feminist theologies as viewed through the lens of a co operative and complementary theological view which is influenced by inter religious Abrahamic and hospitable approaches to dialogue

forecasting the positive role that religions can play in resolving conflicts **Oliver O'Donovan's Moral Theology** Samuel Tranter, 2020-10-01 This book offers the first sustained full length treatment of the wide ranging work of major Anglican theologian Oliver O Donovon Analyzing such key texts as Resurrection and Moral Order The Desire of the Nations and Ethics as Theology Samuel Tranter shows that the relationship between eschatology and ethics is an area of significant tension in O Donovon s evolving vision of moral theology Tranter traces this tension as it relates to O Donovon s writing and contemporary discussion around natural law divine command and human flourishing as well as to particular topics such as poverty marriage and singleness and biotechnology He also connects it with the broader doctrinal features of O Donovon s project such as his accounts of creation sin and redemption and his understanding of the relationships between the cross and the resurrection on one hand and Christology and pneumatology on the other Throughout Tranter indicates the implications of these themes for our understanding of the Christian life This volume establishes and evaluates O Donovon s influence on contemporary Christian ethicists and political theologians such as Luke Bretherton Gilbert Meilaender Jean Porter and Brent Waters and engages with critical readings of O Donovon such as those by Stanley Hauerwas and Gerald McKenny In conversation with these and other voices from a range of perspectives Tranter shows how O Donovon s proposals may be appropriated and amended as a resource for theology and ethics going forward Jewish-Christian Dialogue and the Life of Wisdom
