Forest Policies, Laws, and Governance in India Asheem Srivastav, 2024-07-16 The book delves into the intricate relationship between India's forest governance laws and policies over time examining their effects on the quality and coverage of the country's forests Historically especially during the British era and the initial phase following independence forests were valued for timber leading to increased deforestation to fulfill the rising demands of shipbuilding railways residential construction and industry The economic benefits derived from converting

forest land for developmental purposes were a key factor in this trend. However, recent statistics indicate that except Maharashtra, most of the forest-rich states including MP and Chhattisgarh have lagged in economic development. The history of overexploitation and diversion for non-forestry use has also led to less forest area per capita. India has lost tree biomass much more than its productivity potential, and the average biological productivity of Indian forest is much below the global average. It is extremely important to restore the health of natural forests, which are by far the best and a highly cost-effective carbon sequestering machine provided by nature. The book also provides research data both at national and global scales to convincingly put forward the contention that natural forests are *sine qua non* and under no circumstances can farm and roadside plantations, tea and coffee plantations, and orchards be a substitute for natural forest for three important reasons: 1) the influence of natural forest on rainfall, 2) the complexity in maintaining energy flow, and 3) the impact of natural forest or deforested sites on soil.

Kanwit examines the development of specialized art commentary in a period when art education became a national concern in Britain. The explosion of Victorian visual culture evident in the rapid expansion of

galleries and museums the technological innovations of which photography is only the most famous the public debates over household design and the high profile granted to such developments as the Aesthetic Movement provided art critics unprecedented social power Scholarship to date however has often been restricted to a narrow collection of male writers on art John Ruskin Walter Pater William Morris and Oscar Wilde By including then influential but now lesser known critics such as Anna Jameson Elizabeth Eastlake and Emilia Dilke and by focusing on critical debates rather than celebrated figures Victorian Art Criticism and the Woman Writer refines our conception of when and how art criticism became a professional discipline in Britain Jameson and Eastlake began to professionalize art criticism well before the 1860s that is before the date commonly ascribed to the professionalization of the discipline Moreover in concentrating on historical facts rather than legends about art these women critics represent an alternative approach that developed the modern conception of art history In a parallel development the novelists under consideration George Eliot Charlotte Bront Anne Bront and Elizabeth Gaskell read a wide range of Victorian art critics and used their lessons in key moments of spectatorship This more inclusive view of Victorian art criticism provides key insights into Victorian literary and aesthetic culture The women critics discussed in this book helped to fashion art criticism as itself a literary genre something almost wholly ascribed to famous male critics

Rachel Carson's *Silent Spring* this important study examines the history industrial uses and harmful effects of the twelve most commonly used organochloride chemicals All have been fully or partially banned by the Stockholm Protocol an international treaty signed by about 120 countries in December 2000 Among the twelve are the dioxins the active ingredient in Agent Orange and polychlorinated biphenyls PCBs which are toxic in minute quantities Johansen pays special attention to the Inuit of the Arctic where these chemicals have been bio accumulating to dangerous levels moving up the food chain to a degree of toxicity that some Inuit mothers are no longer able to safely breast feed their infants The polar stratospheric ozone has been devastated by emissions of chlorofluorocarbons CFCs and new scientific findings connect global warming near the Earth's surface to significant cooling in the stratosphere This synergy aggravates ozone depletion because the chemical reactions that destroy the ozone become more energetic as temperatures drop Synthetic toxins have taken their toll on minority ethnic groups in the United States and persistent organic pollutants have inflicted physiological damage on humans
