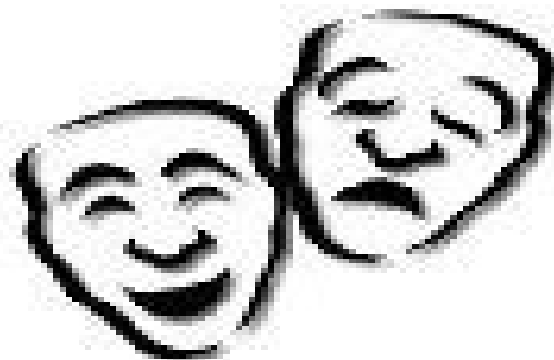

approaches lead to a dead end Firstly it is impossible to prove that someone is a paragon of mental health not a covert homosexual and unmoved by a parent s death Secondly these speculations explain only a small part of Nietzsche s personal statements found in his writings Thirdly and most importantly they do not change our understanding of his ideas and how they were arrived at they do not increase our appreciation of him and do not leave us with any lessons for life the goal of any good writing according to Nietzsche
