that thought had certain requirements and conditions of its own. If the real world was to be understood through thought, there was a question whether thought and the real corresponded in all respects and therefore whether they had the same conditions and laws or whether some of these were peculiar to thought alone. For the solution of this problem it was necessary to study thought and the process of knowing and the conditions which the manner of knowing placed upon our interpretation of the real.
