ethnographic observations within one of America's medium security prisons as well as 82 interviews with currently incarcerated men and the institutional staff members tasked with overseeing them. Pulling together these accounts it paints a picture of daily labors on the inside showing that not all prison jobs are the same nor are all imprisoned workers treated equally. While some find value and purpose in higher paying more desirable jobs others struggle against monotony and hardship in lower paying deskilled work assignments. The result is a stratified prison employment system in which race ethnicity nationality and social class help determine one's position in the labor hierarchy and as a result their experiences of incarceration and ability to prepare for release. Through insightful first hand perspectives and rich ethnographic detail *Orange Collar Labor* takes the reader inside the prison workplace illustrating the formal prison economy as well as the informal black market on which many rely to survive. Highlighting moments of struggle and suffering as well as hard work cooperation resistance and dignity in harsh environments it documents the lives of America's working prisoners so often obscured from view.

Thugs and Thieves Joanne Savage, Kevin H. Wozniak, 2016-04-01 It's often assumed that criminologists know a great deal about violent offenders but in fact there is little consensus about what distinguishes them from those who commit less serious crimes. There is even less agreement about whether violent offenders can be distinguished from chronic nonviolent offenders at all. The challenging question remains why do some individuals commit violent offenses while so many others restrict themselves to nonviolent ones. *Thugs and Thieves* argues that understanding the differential etiology of violence constitutes a fundamental chasm in the criminological literature. In the introductory chapters the authors lay out the important theoretical and methodological deficiencies that have obstructed the production of a clear set of findings to answer this question. criminal trajectories have taken hold as important areas of investigation for researchers interested in the longitudinal study of crime. This accessible volume presents the first full length overview of criminal trajectories as a concept and methodology and makes the case for a developmental approach to the topic. The volume shows how a developmental perspective is important from a practical standpoint helping to inform the design of prevention and early intervention programs to forestall the onset of antisocial and criminal activity particularly when it begins in childhood. Crime in this view does not suit a one size fits all model. There are different types of criminals who develop as the result of different types of developmental factors and experiences. By considering what risk factors may set the stage for later crimes in certain circumstances the authors argue that we may be able to intervene at any point along the life course and if addressed early enough prevent criminal behavior from taking root.
