Williams, 1996 Can corporations remain socially responsible in today's fiercely competitive global economy For several decades after World War II companies like IBM which exemplified what journalist Robert J Samuelson called the good corporation poured forth material comforts and technological ideas while guaranteeing full employment and adequate retirement In the 1980s all of that changed as corporations moved to downsize and become lean mean global competitors In this collection thirteen prominent scholars in business ethics finance management and religion and six corporate leaders respond to a new essay by Samuelson that sounds the death knell of the good corporation They propose new approaches to corporate integrity and social responsibility in the global economy The book will be useful in corporate workshops and will make an excellent business ethics text in philosophy departments and business schools

The Death of Corporate Reputation Jonathan Macey, 2013-03-20 Why did the financial scandals really happen Why are they continuing to happen In *The Death of Corporate Reputation* Yale's Jonathan Macey reveals the real non-intuitive reason and offers a new path forward For over a century law firms investment banks accounting firms credit rating agencies and companies seeking regular access to U S capital markets made large investments in their reputations They treated customers well and sometimes endured losses in transactions or business deals in order to sustain and nurture their reputations as faithful brokers and gate keepers This has changed completely The existing business model among leading participants in today's capital markets no longer treats customers as valued clients whose trust must be earned and nurtured but as one-off counterparties to whom no duties are owed and no loyalty is required The rough and tumble norms of the market place have replaced the long-standing reputational model in U S finance This book describes the transformation in American finance from the old reputational model to the existing laissez faire model and argues that the change came as a result of three factors 1 the growth of reliance on regulation rather than reputation as the primary mechanism for protecting customers and 2 the increasing complexity of regulation which made technical expertise rather than reputation the primary criterion on which customers choose who to do business with in today's markets and 3 the rise of the cult of personality on Wall Street which has led to a secular demise in the relevance of companies' reputations and the concomitant rise of individual rain makers' reputation as the basis for premium pricing of financial services This compelling book will drive the debate about the financial crisis and financial regulation for years to come both inside and outside the industry
