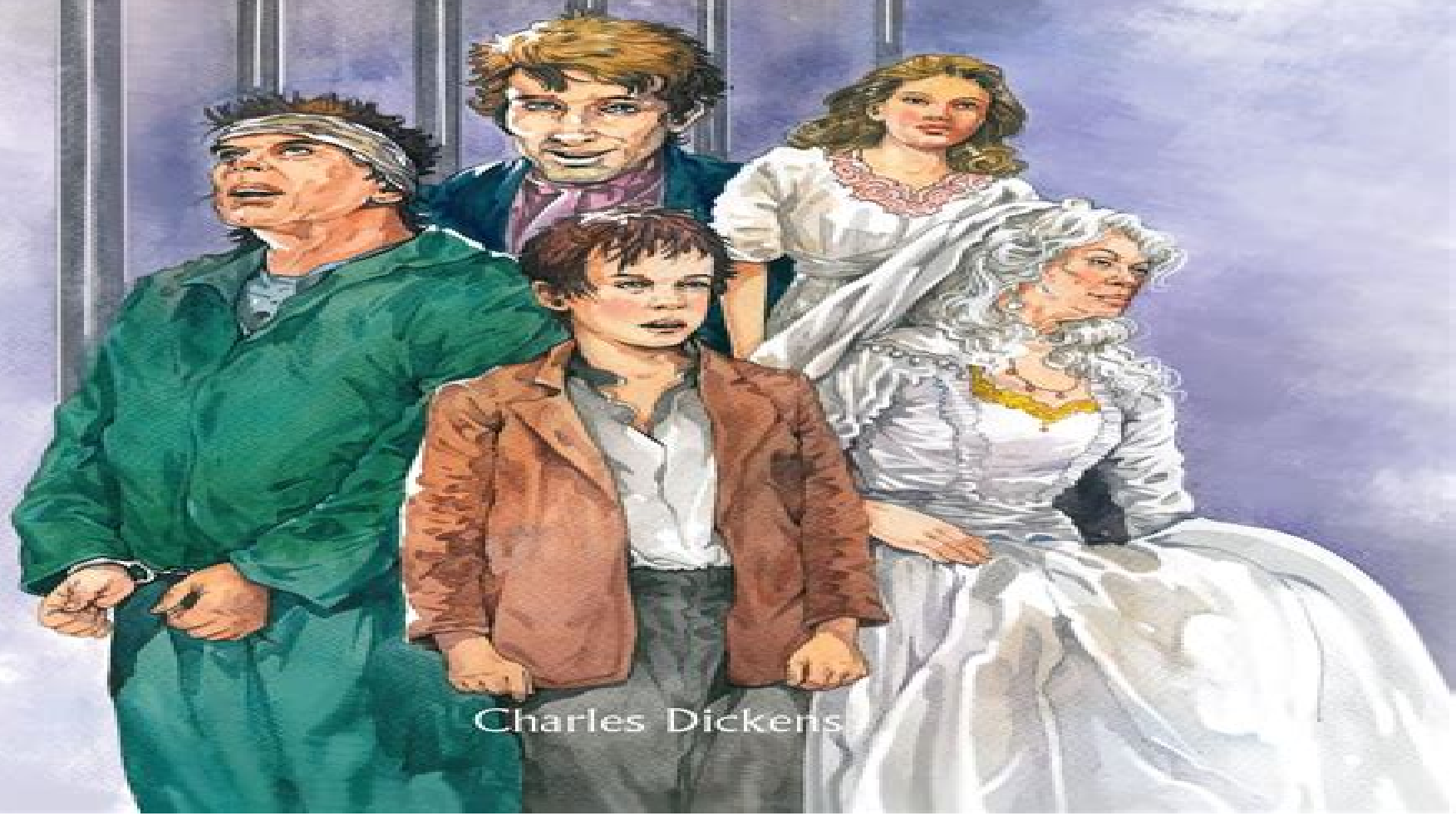

It is Dickens's second novel after *David Copperfield* to be fully narrated in the first person. The novel was first published as a serial in Dickens's weekly periodical *All the Year Round* from 1 December 1860 to August 1861. In October 1861, Chapman and Hall published the novel in three volumes. It is set among marshes in Kent and in London in the early to mid 1800s and contains some of Dickens's most memorable scenes, including the opening in a graveyard where the young Pip is accosted by the escaped convict Abel Magwitch. *Great Expectations* is full of extreme imagery, poverty, prison ships, and chains and fights to the death, and has a colourful cast of characters who have entered popular culture. These include the eccentric Miss Havisham, the beautiful but cold Estella, and Joe, the kind and generous blacksmith.
