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Is There Life After Death? Jürgen Moltmann, 1998 *Theology as Hope* Ryan A. Neal, 2009-01-01 Hope is the leitmotiv of Jürgen Moltmann's theology. Not merely one aspect of his project, hope is the whole of it, the supreme doctrine interpenetrating all others. Indeed, hope is his method. The present study is both historical and developmental while also being analytical and interrogative. This chronological exploration seeks to show the nature, composition, and development of Moltmann's doctrine of hope as the distinctive doctrine of his theology implicating all others. Part I establishes Moltmann's doctrine of hope as grounded in God's faithfulness in the cross and resurrection. Part II investigates major doctrines in his project in light of this ground. This design seeks to take advantage of the chronological approach while also integrating the best elements of a topical approach.

Without personal authenticity, no one will believe in the truth of their message. Jürgen Moltmann, from his lecture *What is a Theologian?* at the Pontifical University Maynooth, Ireland, 1998. Jürgen Moltmann was born into a secular family of teachers in Hamburg in 1926. His plans to study mathematics and physics were interrupted by the destruction of Hamburg in July of 1943. He was one of only a few students serving in the anti-aircraft battery in the central city that survived the Royal Air Force fire storm that killed over 40,000. He spent the next three years as a prisoner of war in labor camps in Belgium and Scotland and finally at Camp Norton near Nottingham in England. After devouring every book that crossed his path during captivity, he eventually turned to reading the psalms and New Testament. These writings soothed his experiences with death, his depression, and his guilt, and ushered along his theology: his belief in God and the power of hope. Jürgen Moltmann's work sprang from the social and political turmoil in post-World War II German culture. In this bibliography, the author lists more than twelve hundred sources from Jürgen Moltmann and more than

eight hundred significant reviews articles and books on his work He has also included most of the theologian s early writings in either German or English through the year 2001 Besides a foreword and essay by Moltmann this volume includes a bibliographic biography of his life Most of his works are listed by title and first place of publication Also listed are later versions and many of the translations Translations of Moltmann s major books in as many European languages as possible as well as a list of known dissertations and monographs presented in reverse chronological order for the reader s convenience make for a well rounded work A research index helps the reader find the major pieces for some of Moltmann

Martyrdom and Memory Elizabeth Castelli, 2004-10-15 Martyrs are produced Elizabeth Castelli suggests not by the lived experience of particular historical individuals but by the stories that are later told about them And the formulaic character of stories about past suffering paradoxically serves specific theological cultural or political ends in the present *Martyrdom and Memory* explores the central role of persecution in the early development of Christian ideas institutions and cultural forms and shows how the legacy of Christian martyrdom plays out in today's world In the pre-Constantinian imperial period the conflict between Roman imperial powers and the subject Christian population hinged on competing interpretations of power submission resistance and victory This book highlights how both Roman and Christian notions of law and piety deployed the same forms of censure and critique each accusing the other of deviations from governing conventions of gender reason and religion Using Maurice Halbwachs's theoretical framework of collective memory and a wide range of Christian sources autobiographical writings martyrologies and saints' lives sermons art objects pilgrimage souvenirs and polemics about spectacle Castelli shows that the writings of early Christians aimed to create public and ideologically potent accounts of martyrdom The martyr's story becomes a usable past and a living tradition for Christian communities and an especially effective vehicle for transmitting ideas about gender power and sanctity An unlikely legacy of early Christian martyrdom is the emergence of modern martyr cults in the wake of the 1999 shootings at Columbine High School Focusing specifically on the martyr cult associated with one of the victims *Martyrdom and Memory* argues that the Columbine story dramatically expresses the ongoing power of collective memory
